





RE: Supreme Court Order Transferring IOLTA Program Management to Nevada Bar Foundation

Dear Chief Justice Gibbons:


The Nevada Bar Foundation is in receipt of the Court's June 19, 2014 Order Amending Supreme Court Rule 216 (ADKT 0479) regarding client interest bearing trust accounts (IOLTA) and the foundation responsible for the administration of such accounts.


The Nevada Bar Foundation is preparing for the transfer of IOLTA program management and is currently recruiting members to serve on the Board of Trustees. If it pleases the Court, any received applications will be forwarded to the Court for its designated appointments.

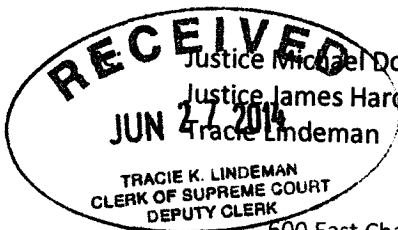
Additionally, in order to effect the transfer of IOLTA assets from the Justice League of Nevada (JLN) to the Nevada Bar Foundation in advance of the October 2014 grant cycle, it would be helpful if the Court included in its order approving the State Bar of Nevada Board of Governor's designation of the Nevada Bar Foundation as the SCR 216 IOLTA foundation, specific direction for JLN to immediately: (1) notify IOLTA participating financial institutions to transfer funds to the Nevada Bar Foundation, EIN 88-0399023; (2) transfer to the Nevada Bar Foundation all IOLTA funds in its possession including all IOLTA funds received during the time JLN was the foundation designated pursuant to SCR 216 and any IOLTA funds it may receive in the future; and (3) transfer to the Nevada Bar Foundation any and all IOLTA books and records, in its possession or control.

On behalf of the Nevada Bar Foundation, I thank the Court for the opportunity to manage this important program. I am available to answer any questions.
