ORDER


On July 31, 2014, this court entered an order appointing the Nevada Bar Foundation (NBF) as the designated SCR 216 IOLTA foundation in place of the Justice League of Nevada (JLN), effective August 31, 2014.


On August 21, 2014, the JLN filed an emergency motion requesting clarification of this court's order. This court subsequently ordered the State Bar Board of Governors and the Nevada Bar Foundation to file a response, which was filed on August 25, 2014.


Having reviewed the motion and response, this court clarifies its previous order in the following respects. In the initial order appointing the NBF as the IOLTA foundation, this court directed that the NBF convert its status from a private foundation to that of a public charity. This condition will have been satisfied upon the NBF's filing with the Internal Revenue Service of a Notice of Termination of Private Foundation Status. The NBF advises this court that the notice will be filed this week. Further, although this court previously directed that the IOLTA assets be


transferred to the NBF on August 31, 2014, because of the holiday closure of the banks, the transfer shall occur on September 2, 2014.

It is so ORDERED.




