Counsel could not only assist Petitioner with a much better presentation of his issues before this Court, but counsel would likewise make much easier this Court's task of discerning the issues and adjudicating them as upon a competent counsel's ability to present same to the Court.

Discretion is given this Court to appoint counsel to Petitioner under NRS 34.750 if it determines first that Petitioner is indigent, and second, that any of the following factors are met: (1) the issues are difficult; (2) the Petitioner is unable to comprehend the proceedings; or (3) counsel is necessary to conduct discovery.  $\underline{Id}$ ., §§ (1)(a) - (1)(c). The severity of Petitioner's sentence is also to be considered.  $\underline{Id}$ ., § (1).

Although not binding on this Court, the Ninth Circuit has held that counsel should be appointed in habeas corpus proceedings when the interests of justice so require, Chaney v. Lewis, 801 F.2d 1191, 1196 (9th Cir.), cert. denied, 481 U.S. 1023 (1987), which increases as the complexities of the case and the penalties for the offense increase, id. Ultimately, attorneys should be appointed for indigent petitioners who can "not adequately present their own cases." Jeffers v. Lewis, 68 F.3d 295, 297-98 (9th Cir. 1995). See also Hawkins v. Bennett, 423 F.2d 948 (8th Cir. 1970)(counsel must be appointed where petitioner is a person of such limited education as to be incapable of presenting his claims fairly).

Although Petitioner need meet but one (1) criteria of NRS 34.750 in order to merit appointment of counsel, he has met all three (3) criteria therein. He furthermore has satisfied the Ninth Circuit's interest of justice test in that the sliding scale tips heavily in favor of appointing him counsel. Indeed, Petitioner's sentence, coupled with the other factors set forth above,

1	demonstrate that counsel's appointment would satisfy not only justice, but
2	fundamental fairness, as well.
3	CONCLUSION
4	For the reasons set forth above, this Court should appoint counsel to
5	represent Petitioner in and for all further proceedings in this post-conviction
6	habeas corpus action.
