

5 THE COURT: Gene Anthony Allen.

6 MR. SWEETIN: Bob Sweetin for the State, bar  
7 number 12647.

8 THE COURT: The Defendant is present and  
9 incarcerated at the department of corrections  
10 representing himself pro se, and Mr. Allen, you know why  
11 we actually brought you down from prison today?

12 THE DEFENDANT: Well, I'm kind of surprised to  
13 see you again.

14 Last time I saw you was David Rogers standing  
15 there, and I got a second amended judgment conviction.  
16 At that time I read it over. Just to let you know, I  
17 can read very well.

18 THE COURT: You can write very well too.

19 THE DEFENDANT: Yeah.

20 And it's clearly stated that it was laches and  
21 statute of limitations barred and procedural bars.

22 THE COURT: You are real good at quoting cases.

23 THE DEFENDANT: Here is the thing though, see we  
24 know --

25 THE COURT: Where are you from, what country are

1 you from?

2 THE DEFENDANT: I'm from Great Britain, I'm  
3 British, and I'm going to miss the Olympics, so that is  
4 a problem.

5 So now I'm up state having the time of my life in  
6 state prison, and the next thing I know all of a sudden  
7 I got your notice from the DAs office in the mail.

8 And may I add, there is a major problem with the  
9 legal mail, the Turner test goes right out the window as  
10 far as safety and mail.

11 I tried to subpoena the mail log through Pershing  
12 County Court, and that is a whole other issue, so I  
13 never got a copy of the filed petition.

14 But I did know there is a difference between  
15 Chapter 34 --

16 THE COURT: You are at Lovelock?

17 THE DEFENDANT: Yeah, that's where I'm at.  
18 I'm at Indian Springs temporarily.

19 Excuse me. My throat is really, really horse,  
20 but I'll try to go as quick as I possibly can.

21 THE COURT: Let me make sure you understand what  
22 we are here for.

23 We're here at the State's request on an order to  
24 show cause why you should not be declared a vexatious  
25 litigant, and subsequently resulting in a pre-filing, a

1 prohibition requiring you to have have approval, a  
2 pre-approval.

3 This is your 16th time you had a writ, and the  
4 State wants you to have been pre-approved before you are  
5 allowed to file any additional writs or motions.

6 And the question is:

7 Why should not that be granted?

8 THE DEFENDANT: Okay. That is a loaded question  
9 because it's not quite that simple because you got to  
10 look at how I got here in the first place.

11 I have the right to file a pleading to a specific  
12 Judge.

13 I filed it to the Department 4.

14 The next thing I know I get a conversion notice  
15 from you.

16 So I did receive some notice, but a conversion is  
17 not the same as having the right to withdraw pending to  
18 amend.

19 THE COURT: It's been my case for six years.

20 THE DEFENDANT: It was a mandamus I filed to a  
21 specific Judge.

22 Now I'm standing in front of you.

23 So this negates -- It seems like to me the State  
24 is bypassing the pleading, my original pleading.

25 What I'm here to -- All these things make no

1 difference to me because I don't plan on ever being in  
2 your Court or any Court in the State of Nevada again.

3 I'm deported, so it's not going to make any  
4 difference to me.

5 My whole goal is Roe -vs- Lindsey, you know, I  
6 have exhausting remedies.

7 I can't go to the feds and say, this happened,  
8 and this happened.

9 Judge Reed or Bolland (Phonetic), or Magistrate  
10 Judge -- Any Federal Judge will say, when did you  
11 present this to the State Court, how, was it exhausted,  
12 was it properly defaulted.

13 Now, you understand the ping pong game here, I go  
14 to the feds. They say, we can't do anything about this,  
15 you need to go back to the State.

16 However, me and you we have crossed paths before,  
17 I can't remember where it was or whatever, I tried to  
18 fire you, and that didn't work obviously because I'm  
19 back in front of you again, just we have different  
20 political views or however it may be, but there is just  
21 some things conflicting here.

22 So regardless of the way the outcome of these  
23 proceedings is today, it has absolutely nothing to do  
24 with the writ, the writ that I wrote -- or the petition  
25 I filed.

1           Let me explain a little further.

2           The petition on file was a writ of mandamus, not  
3 a writ of habeas corpus.

4           You never gave me the opportunity to withdraw,  
5 and/or amend the record.

6           I would have withdrawn it if I would have known I  
7 would have dragged the Court in for absolutely nothing.

8           This is nonsensical.

9           Where this started out in the original petition I  
10 filed, I filed a writ of mandamus because me and Pam  
11 Miller (Phonetic) down at program services, department  
12 of corrections, sent me a letter saying, you don't apply  
13 to transfer your sentence to you, the Judge.

14           The United Kingdom says, it depends -- According  
15 to Great Britain, that depends on the circumstances of  
16 the case.

17           Lifetime supervision, that wasn't explained to me  
18 at sentencing, it had to be waived, along with any  
19 restitution, and/or fines.

20           So now I'm standing here going, wait a minute,  
21 none of this was explained to me at sentencing.

22           I was kind of proud of you to explain some of the  
23 immigration issues to show the people in the courtroom,  
24 but that was never done by McGroarty.

25           However, you are not my sentencing Judge.



1           Now, this is where it gets nonsensical.

2           All I wanted was an application to fill out to  
3 put on file to be eligible.

4           Miss Miller sent me the paperwork saying, well,  
5 we're not going to send you an application because you  
6 don't qualify.

7           Well, okay, if I don't qualify -- Then she says  
8 she sent me another letter says, you can apply in two  
9 years.

10           I said, no, I never applied in the first place,  
11 and if I never applied in the first place, how is it  
12 she's saying I don't qualify.

13           Regardless of whether I qualify or don't qualify,  
14 I have a protected liberty interest, and I'm looking out  
15 for my best interest that I have the right to have an  
16 application on file with the State.

17           That was my position, and that is when I filed a  
18 writ of mandamus to compel the Court to get them to just  
19 send me an application. That is why I'm here. That was  
20 the original petition, which I never got a copy of may I  
21 add.

22           Now, all of a sudden we get a conversion, and  
23 according to you, it never gave me the opportunity to  
24 withdraw or amend the record, or fix any jurisdictional  
25 defects, and now I'm standing in front of you on what

1 I'm understanding there is a writ of habeas corpus.

2 So I'm asking the Court now, what writ am I  
3 standing here on?

4 THE COURT: You are actually not here on a writ  
5 at all.

6 You are here on the State's motion.

7 THE DEFENDANT: I rest.

8 THE COURT: An order to show cause actually.

9 THE DEFENDANT: What happened to my original  
10 petition?

11 THE COURT: It was denied.

12 THE DEFENDANT: I appealed that order, but the  
13 Nevada Supreme Court is saying it wasn't an appealable  
14 order because it was never denied because I still had a  
15 court date pending.

16 THE COURT: You jumped the gun.

17 You appealed it before you gave me a chance to  
18 deny it.

19 THE DEFENDANT: Is it still pending now?

20 THE COURT: No, it's denied now.

21 You can go appeal it.

22 THE DEFENDANT: It's going to be denied today with  
23 these proceedings?

24 THE COURT: It was already previously denied, but  
25 we're here to address whether or not after 16 writs and

1 numerous other motions you should be declared a  
2 vexatious litigant, and here is what is necessary:

3 First of all, you were noticed, but basically if  
4 I understand it correctly, there are four basic things  
5 that need to be done in order to have this accomplished.

6 First of all, the Defendant needs to be notified,  
7 which he's been notified and is present.

8 Secondly, I got to create a record that explains  
9 what it is happened historically that puts this case in  
10 that posture, and in that regard I need to put on the  
11 record here's what happened:

12 The Defendant was convicted in 2003 pursuant to a  
13 plea agreement. I'm not going to read the charge. You  
14 ended up pleading guilty to two cases, for which the  
15 charges were sentenced to life with the possibility of  
16 parole after ten years on one and a concurrent 5 to 20  
17 years on the second count.

18 So you had those two counts running concurrent.

19 THE DEFENDANT: But I'm eligible for parole.

20 THE COURT: You are eligible for parole in a few  
21 more years, and that will be in a year or two -- or you  
22 are probably eligible for parole now.

23 The Defendant filed a Notice of Appeal in April  
24 2003, and the Supreme Court affirmed his conviction in  
25 March of 2004.

1           THE DEFENDANT: Your Honor, that was after  
2 counsel withdrew.

3           THE COURT: I'm making a record here.

4           In June of 2003 you filed this first petition for  
5 writ of habeas corpus. That part is a little bit  
6 confusing because it was before somebody, but never a  
7 formal order ever entered.

8           In any event, the Defendant filed his second  
9 petition for writ of habeas corpus in December 2003.  
10 Findings of fact and conclusions of law in that petition  
11 were in fact entered, and it was counsel withdrew on  
12 that case in February 2004, and that writ was denied in  
13 March of 2004.

14           The Defendant filed his third petition for writ  
15 of habeas corpus, and the State responded. We had a  
16 hearing, and it was denied by the District Court in June  
17 of 2004, was appealed to the Supreme Court --

18           THE DEFENDANT: Excuse me.

19           THE COURT: Let me make this record.

20           The Supreme Court affirmed the District Court's  
21 dismissal, and a remittitur was in January of 2005.

22           On August 10th, 2004 -- You notice how this is  
23 working.

24           He is filing additional petitions before the  
25 remittitur.

1           The last one is even sent back from the Supreme  
2 Court, just pointing that out, so the record can reflect  
3 that.

4           August 10th, 2004 the Defendant filed his fourth  
5 petition for post conviction relief.

6           On August 17th of 2004 the Defendant filed his  
7 fifth petition.

8           That was only a week apart.

9           No possible way either one of those could be  
10 heard.

11           In September 2004, this is the District Court  
12 dismissed the petition, finds that they were successive,  
13 and without merit, and failed to have good cause.

14           The sixth petition for post conviction relief was  
15 filed in November 2004, was also denied as being  
16 successive.

17           August 24th, 2005 the Defendant filed his seventh  
18 petition for writ habeas corpus. The State filed an  
19 opposition. Again, argument was heard in that matter in  
20 August of 2000 -- or excuse me, October of 2005, and it  
21 was denied. Findings of fact for that hearing were  
22 filed.

23           He filed his eighth post-conviction writ of  
24 habeas on April 2006, the Defendant. The State filed a  
25 response. Hearing was held in May 2006. Petition was

1 denied, and findings of fact, and he appealed that, and  
2 January 2007 the Supreme Court confirmed the order  
3 dismissing the writ.

4 In February 2007 the Defendant filed his ninth  
5 post-conviction petition.

6 Then on February 15th, two weeks later, or ten  
7 days later, he filed his tenth petition for post  
8 conviction relief.

9 On August 7th -- -or I mean, March 2007 the State  
10 filed a response, and by April of 2007 it was denied.

11 March 17th, 2008 the Defendant filed his eleventh  
12 post-conviction writ. It was dismissed.

13 Notice of Appeal was filed, and the Supreme Court  
14 affirmed two District Court's order dismissing the  
15 petition.

16 In February of 2009 -- On April 2008 the  
17 Defendant filed his twelfth post-conviction petition,  
18 and the Court heard argument, and findings of fact were  
19 filed denying the petition.

20 February 3rd, 2009 the Defendant filed his  
21 thirteenth post-conviction petition.

22 In June of 2009 the Defendant filed his  
23 fourteenth post-conviction, just a few months later.

24 On July of '09 the Court entered an order  
25 dismissing the fourteenth petition, and he appealed, and

1 the Supreme Court affirmed the dismissal.

2 He filed a motion for reconsideration August of  
3 2009.

4 The Court denied it, then he appealed that, and  
5 there was no statutory authority to dismiss a motion to  
6 reconsider.

7 So the fifteenth petition for writ of habeas  
8 corpus was filed February of 2010. The State filed a  
9 response. Findings of fact, conclusions of law, entered  
10 and dismissed in August 2010.

11 In addition to those fifteen, this is actually  
12 the sixteenth one we're dealing with now.

13 And in addition to those, the Defendant filed a  
14 multitude of motions, which have been denied and also  
15 appealed.

16 So that a record having been made --

17 THE DEFENDANT: Can I speak?

18 THE COURT: No, it's my turn.

19 I find that the petitions having been now  
20 numbered sixteen in number have been without merit, have  
21 have been successive, have been time barred, and are  
22 addressing matters that this Court has absolutely no  
23 authority to even address, the vast majority of them, so  
24 I think that that probably addresses not only the  
25 background in terms of the filings, but also the

1 substantive legal issues that they are without merit,  
2 and I don't have any jurisdiction to really address them  
3 even if they were ever -- if I ever addressed the  
4 merits, I have no authority to do anything that the  
5 Defendant's requesting, like the last one he wants me to  
6 do something about transferring his sentence, so he can  
7 serve his sentence in England.

8 THE DEFENDANT: Wait a minute, Your Honor. That  
9 is not the issue.

10 I explained the issue was an application --

11 THE COURT: It's still my turn.

12 THE DEFENDANT: It's being withheld from the  
13 State.

14 THE COURT: The Defendant's going to be a  
15 vexatious litigator, and he's going to hence forward be  
16 subject to a pre-screening process, wherein he has to  
17 submit anything he wants to file in terms of a writ,  
18 post conviction relief of any form or fashion, any  
19 motion, anything asking for any kind of relief, has to  
20 be done by way I believe of an application seeking leave  
21 to file such, has to be submitted through the clerk's  
22 office and will be pre-screened by myself, and once that  
23 has been accomplished, he's not being deprived of his  
24 right to file, not to have -- Let me rephrase that.

25 He's not being deprived of his right to have



1 whatever he is seeking a review, it will be reviewed, I  
2 will review every one, but will not be going through the  
3 clerk's office, and will not be filed, unless I find  
4 that there is some merit to what he's seeking.

5 In that case then I will grant an order  
6 specifically allowing the Defendant to proceed to file  
7 whatever motion or post conviction relief he is  
8 requesting.

9 MR. SWEETIN: One more thing, Your Honor, just  
10 for clarification purposes.

11 Under the Jordan factors, along with notice to  
12 the Defendant, he has to be given the opportunity to  
13 respond, which the State would submit he's had today,  
14 and he's had also since April 30th when the State filed  
15 this counter-motion.

16 THE DEFENDANT: I haven't received mail. I'm  
17 having mail problems.

18 That is a security interest in its own.

19 THE COURT: I'll even do this --

20 THE DEFENDANT: Can I address the Court?

21 THE COURT: Here's what I'm going to suggest:

22 I'll let you address the Court, but actually  
23 since you are here I'll let you do this, if you want to  
24 do this, as long as you understand what you are  
25 addressing, you are addressing your overall status as a

1 vexatious litigant, and if you want to file an actual  
2 written response, I'll give you an opportunity to  
3 specifically respond.

4 THE DEFENDANT: I'm probably not going to do  
5 that.

6 THE COURT: I'm giving you an opportunity.

7 THE DEFENDANT: Okay. I'll think about it.

8 THE COURT: You can do whatever you want to do.

9 THE DEFENDANT: Here's the situation:  
10 I'm in the wrong courtroom, first of all.

11 THE COURT: You want to be in Federal Court.

12 THE DEFENDANT: I want to be in Federal Court,  
13 right, but I explained it to you before, it seems  
14 nonsensical, but it's not. There is a method to the  
15 madness here.

16 They are telling me --

17 THE COURT: It's madness all right.

18 THE DEFENDANT: Right, but they are telling me I  
19 have to exhaust -- Now you are making it look a lot --

20 THE COURT: I'm going to make it easy for you.

21 THE DEFENDANT: You are not looking at Rex Bell.  
22 You are the fourth Judge.

23 THE COURT: Let me make it easier for you.

24 I have a declaration that you have exhausted all  
25 of your State Court remedies.

1           How is that?

2           THE DEFENDANT: Say that again.

3           THE COURT: If you keep being told in Federal  
4 Court they can't give you any relief because you have  
5 not exhausted your State Court remedies, I am making a  
6 declaration that you have in fact exhausted all of your  
7 State Court remedies of which I'm aware of.

8           THE DEFENDANT: Yeah, me too because each and  
9 every one of those petitions have been --

10          THE COURT: Do you want to file anything?

11          THE DEFENDANT: Probably not, but it will be  
12 taken up by the Nevada Supreme Court, I reserve the  
13 right.

14          Can I ask you for one thing?

15          Can you see I get a transcript of these  
16 proceedings?

17          THE COURT: Absolutely.

18          THE DEFENDANT: That way I don't have to file  
19 another motion, and be denied, and then we go again.

20          MR. SWEETIN: The State will prepare the order.

21          THE COURT: Prepare the order.

22          There you go.

23          (Proceedings concluded).


