
Please accept this letter as a follow-up response from the Clark County Bar Association (CCBA) regarding the proposed amendments to Supreme Court Rule 207, and the related July 24, 2018 amended order scheduling a public hearing to take place on September 20, 2018, at 2:00 p.m.

Under the current rules, the CCBA falls under the exempt status, Regulation 7, Special Provider Provisions, E. "the program for which CLE approval is sought is of duration not to exceed 1.5 hours and for which the registration fee does not exceed \$75."

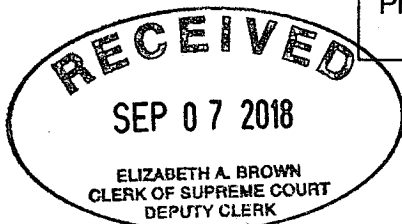
While we appreciate that CCBA has been able to operate as an exempt provider, under the amended order, since January 1, 2017, we have received various feedback from both attorneys and judges who have instructed and/or attended CCBA produced CLE seminars. Based on the feedback received, the 1.5 hour limit needs to be increased to allow instructors more time to present their educational information and for attorneys to receive full hours of quality education as stated in Regulation 3, Academic Standards.

The CCBA respectfully requests that the program time limit, in Regulation 7, Special Provider Provisions, E be raised from the current 1.5 hours to 2 full hours, per CLE seminar, with no additional fees assessed to this exempt organization. The CCBA appreciates your consideration of this request.
