ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF SENTENCE

Before this Court is a *Notice of Motion and Motions* [sic] *for Modification of Sentence* filed June 16, 2016 by Defendant FRANK M. PECK, a self-represented litigant. The STATE OF NEVADA (the "State") through Chief Appellate Deputy Terrence P. McCarthy, filed its *Opposition to Motion for Modification of Sentence* on June 23, 2016. Mr. Peck filed his *Reply to Opposition to Motion for Modification of Sentence* on July 5, 2016 and the matter was submitted to this Court for decision.

On March 17, 1998, Mr. Peck was sentenced to two consecutive terms of life in prison arising out of a jury verdict finding him guilty of two counts of sexual assault. Mr. Peck challenges the sentence imposed, arguing the sentencing judge, the Honorable Steven Kosach, relied on mistaken assumptions about Mr. Peck's criminal record at sentencing. *Motion*. Mr. Peck raises the following errors are material mistakes of fact in his

presentence investigation report ("PSI"): (1) to his knowledge, he honorably completed probation arising out of his April 12, 1990 arrest date; (2) the first paragraph on page 4 is materially false and misleading, as Mr. Peck was "expunged;" (3) as to the last paragraph on page 4, Mr. Peck was arrested once during probation, instead of three times, and was the victim of battery in jail; (4) the last paragraph on page 10 is an extremely prejudicial reference to a false arrest/mistaken identity; and (5) he "notes" for the second paragraph on page 4, he was lawfully driving the vehicle subject to a grand theft auto charge. He also argues he did not possess a firearm for the charge of assault with a firearm on a person. See Motion.

Mr. Peck also seeks to challenge the victim's testimony and the evidence presented at his first and second trials, arguing he was sentenced to life in prison "based on the [victim's] equivocal answer" that he digitally penetrated her. <u>See Motion</u>.

A district court has authority to correct or modify a sentence which is the result of the sentencing judge's misapprehension of a defendant's criminal record. State v. Eighth Judicial Dist. In & For Clark County, 100 Nev. 90, 97, 677 P.2d 1044, 1048 (1984). A motion to modify a sentence "is limited in scope to sentences based on mistaken assumptions about a defendant's criminal record which work to the defendant's extreme detriment." Edwards v. State, 112 Nev. 704, 708, 918 P.2d 321, 324 (1996); see also, Passanisi v. State, 108 Nev. 318, 323, 831 P.2d 1371, 1373-74 (1992) overruled on other grounds by Harris v. State, 130 Nev. Adv. Op. 47, 329 P.3d 619 (2014). A defendant seeking modification of his sentence must show, (1) that the district court actually sentenced the defendant "based on a materially false assumption of fact that worked to [the defendant's] extreme detriment," and, (2) that "the particular mistake at issue was of the

type that would rise to the level of a violation of due process." Id.

The Court notes the significant passage of time between Mr. Peck's sentencing and his challenges to his sentence and PSI. However, the Nevada Supreme Court has explained, "Because of the very nature of the remedy sought in a motion for relief from a sentence that is either facially illegal or is the result of a mistaken assumption regarding a criminal defendant's record, time constraints and procedural defaults necessarily do not apply." Edwards, 112 Nev. at 708.1

Because a motion to modify a sentence is based on "very narrow due process grounds," a district court should summarily deny a motion that raises issues "outside the very narrow scope" of a motion to modify sentence. <u>Id.</u> at 708, n2. In this case, the Court summarily denies the portion of Mr. Peck's *Motion* that seeks to challenge the validity of his sentence based on the victim's testimony at trial because that claim is outside the narrow grounds set forth in <u>Edwards</u> and must instead be raised in a habeas corpus petition to the extent it has not already been raised or is barred.

As to the remaining claims, this Court has carefully reviewed the extensive transcript of the sentencing hearing in this case. The Court finds Mr. Peck's second and fourth claims, as to the materially false and misleading information regarding a prior sexual offense dated February 25, 1983, are without merit. The record reveals Mr. Peck's counsel objected at the time of sentencing, the objection was sustained, and the judge disregarded the information concerning the February 25, 1983 sexual assault. See *Transcript of Sentencing*, p. 108.

¹ The Court declines to consider the State's citation to unpublished authority because, (1) the unpublished case is procedurally dissimilar in that it involved a "motion to withdraw guilty plea" after a significant amount of time passed from sentencing; and (2) the Nevada Supreme Court amended NRAP 36 and SCR 123 to allow citation to Nevada Supreme Court opinions entered **on or after January 1, 2016.** ADKT 0504. The State cites to an unpublished opinion from 2009.

The Court further rejects Mr. Peck's remaining claims, because he has failed to show the information was materially false or that Judge Kosach actually sentenced Mr. Peck based on the alleged materially false information and that it worked to his extreme detriment. Edwards, supra. Mr. Peck provides no argument or discussion of due process violations and the Court finds none. Compare, Shields v. State, 97 Nev. 472, 473, 634 P.2d 468, 469 (1981) (prejudice shown where record revealed sentencing judge's decision was manifestly affected by information contained in PSI and police reports that were not given to defendant prior to sentencing).

Instead, the record reflects a very thorough sentencing wherein Judge Kosach carefully considered all factors, both mitigating and aggravating, presented by Mr. Peck's counsel and the State at the time of Mr. Peck's sentencing. Because there was no misapprehension, mistaken assumption, or materially false information that worked to Mr. Peck's extreme detriment, his *Motion* must be denied.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Motion for Modification of Sentence filed by FRANK

M. PECK is DENIED.
