I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY.

The instant action arises from Mr. Peck's 1998 Judgment of Conviction for two counts of sexual assault entered after a trial by jury. After his conviction, Mr. Peck filed a direct appeal to the Nevada Supreme Court on March 19, 1998. *Notice of Appeal to Supreme Court.* Mr. Peck's conviction was affirmed. Peck v. State, Order of Affirmance, Docket No. 32031, filed in Second Judicial District Court Case Number CR96-2687 on September 25, 2000.

Mr. Peck subsequently filed the following eight (8) petitions for post-conviction relief:

1) Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed September 19, 2001; 2)

Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed August 7, 2008; 3) First Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed April 28, 2010; 4) Supplemental Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed November 21, 2011; 5) Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed August 30, 2013; 6) Supplemental Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus filed December 5, 2013; 7) Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed October 4, 2016; and 8) First Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) filed January 26, 2017. All petitions were dismissed or denied.

Mr. Peck additionally filed a Common Law Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Not Post-Conviction) Writ NRS 34.360-34.631 Constitutional Challenge to NRS 34.220-34.830. ("Petition") on February 16, 2018, challenging the constitutionality of NRS 34.220-34.830. This Court dismissed the Petition without prejudice pursuant to NRCP 41(a)(2). Mr. Peck then filed his Motion for Relief From Order Filed Herein on 9-7-2018 Erroneously Dismissing Common Law Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Not Post Conviction), arguing the Court

erred in dismissing the *Petition* and its *Order* should be set aside pursuant to NRCP Rule 60(b). The Court denied this request and ordered the dismissal was without prejudice.

Order Denying Motion for Relief from Order Erroneously Dismissing Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, p. 4.

On March 7, 2019, Mr. Peck filed the *NRCP Rule 60(b)(3) Motion* requesting this Court set aside its *Judgment of Conviction* pursuant to Rule 60(b) of the Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure on the basis the government fraudulently concealed and failed to disclose material facts in his case. On June 17, 2019, the Court entered the *Order Denying NRCP Rule 60(B) Motion*.

On July 5, 2019, Mr. Peck filed the *Motion for Leave to Rehear NRCP Rule 60(b)(3) Motion [DCR Rule 13(7); NRCP Rule 60(b)(2)].* On November 7, 2019, the Court entered the *Order Denying Motion for Leave to Rehear NRCP Rule 60(b)(3) Motion.* Mr. Peck appealed this Court's denial and the Nevada Supreme Court entered its *Order Dismissing Appeal* on February 3, 2020.

Mr. Peck then filed the instant *Petition* on June 10, 2020. Mr. Peck argues the claims in the *Petition* were not available due to *Brady* material concealed by the State and Federal government. Id. Ground One argues ineffective assistance of counsel for failing to argue that DNA is synthetic, extrinsic, and fake. *Petition*, p. 6. Ground Two states Mr. Peck's counsel was ineffective for failing to challenge the Court's jurisdiction which it fraudulently conferred on Mr. Peck by establishing a "momentary trust" at Mr. Peck's arraignment. *Petition*, p. 7. Ground Three contends Mr. Peck's counsel was ineffective for failing to discover that NRS 200.366 was enacted by resolution and not by bill. *Petition*, p. 8. Ground Four states Mr. Peck's rights were violated by Chapter 34's usurpation of ineffective

assistance of counsel claims and by the passage of seven (7) years before he had an evidentiary hearing. *Petition*, p. 9.

II. LAW AND ANALYSIS.

This is Mr. Peck's ninth successive petition for writ of habeas corpus. Successive petitions such as Mr. Peck's are subject to mandatory dismissal pursuant to Chapter 34 of the Nevada Revised Statutes. "Application of the statutory procedural default rules to post-conviction habeas petitions is mandatory." State v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court ex rel. County of Clark, 121 Nev. 225, 231, 112 P.3d 1070, 1074 (2005). Successive petitions must be dismissed pursuant to NRS 34.810 if the grounds for the petition were already raised on direct appeal or in a prior petition for writ of habeas corpus and considered on the merits or the grounds could have been raised in a prior petition. NRS 34.810; Brown v. McDaniel, 130 Nev. Adv. Op. 60, 331 P.3d 867, 870 (2014); State v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 121 Nev. at 232.

Similarly, "if it plainly appears on the face" of a second or successive petition and the documents or the records on file with the court that the petitioner is not entitled to relief, then a judge shall enter an order for summary dismissal. NRS 34.745(4).

Further, Section 34.726 of the Nevada Revised Statutes provides as follows:

Unless there is good cause shown for delay, a petition that challenges the validity of a judgment or sentence must be filed within 1 year of entry of judgment of conviction, or if an appeal has been taken from the judgment, within 1 year after the appellate court...issues its remittitur.

NRS 34.726(1) (emphasis added).

Good cause exists if the petitioner can show to the satisfaction of the court that, "(a) the delay is not the fault of the petitioner; and (b) dismissal of the petition as untimely will unduly prejudice the petitioner." NRS 34.726(1). Good cause is defined as "a substantial"

reason that affords a legal excuse." <u>Brown</u>, 130 Nev. Adv. Op. 60, 331 P.3d at 870 (internal quotations omitted). To show good cause, Mr. Peck must demonstrate that "an impediment external to the defense prevented him from complying with procedural rules." <u>Id.</u> An "impediment external to the defense may be demonstrated by a showing that the factual or legal basis for the claim was not reasonably available to counsel or that some interference by officials made compliance impracticable." <u>Hathaway v. State</u>, 119 Nev. 248, 252, 71 P.3d 503, 506 (2003).

Mr. Peck's *Petition* is procedurally barred without good cause. A review of the record reveals <u>Ground One</u> and <u>Ground Three</u> have each been raised in prior petitions. NRS 34.810. <u>Ground Two</u> and <u>Ground Four</u> could have been raised in prior petitions and are procedurally barred, absent good cause, of which Mr. Peck does not make a showing. Mr. Peck makes a blanket statement that none of this information was available to him because the State and Federal government concealed this information. However, he does allege facts specific enough to overcome the procedural bar to successive claims. NRS 34.726(1).

Mr. Peck's <u>Ground One</u> claims the DNA evidence is fake and his counsel was ineffective for not discrediting DNA evidence. Mr. Peck previously argued this on page four of his *Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction)* filed on August 30, 2013.

Although worded differently, it is clear Mr. Peck is attacking DNA evidence as fake because it is synthetic, non-biological evidence. This Court denied the 2013 *Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction)* in the *Order* entered on April 9, 2014. This Court's *Order* was confirmed in the *Order of Affirmance* entered by the Nevada Supreme Court on December 1, 2014. Mr. Peck has therefore previously raised this claim and it is barred.

Mr. Peck's <u>Ground Two</u> argument is the Court does not have jurisdiction because the Court tricked Mr. Peck by forcing him to enter into a trust in which the Judge was the trustee, the District Attorney was the executor, and Mr. Peck was the beneficiary. This argument relates back to the day of Mr. Peck's arraignment. Mr. Peck provides no explanation why he has never presented this argument before as he was clearly at his own arraignment, nor does he explain how the government covered this information up, leading to his delayed claim. Mr. Peck simply does not provide an adequate factual basis to overcome the procedural bar. The claim is therefore procedurally barred.

Ground Three of Mr. Peck's *Petition* argues NRS 200.366 is void because it was enacted via resolution and not by bill. This argument was previously raised in Mr. Peck's *Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction)* filed on October 4, 2016. The argument was disposed of in the Court's *Order Dismissing Successive Petitions for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction)* entered on April 7, 2017. This Court's *Order* was affirmed by the *Order of Affirmance* entered by the Nevada Court of Appeals on December 17, 2017. The Nevada Court of Appeals found Mr. Peck "confuses Nevada's actual laws with Nevada's codified statutes. The Nevada Revised Statutes 'constituted the official codified version of the Statutes of Nevada and may be cited as prima facie evidence of the law.' NRS. 220.170(3)."

Ground Four of Mr. Peck's *Petition* argues he is entitled to relief because Chapter 34 of the Nevada Revised Statutes usurps claims of ineffective assistance of counsel. While Mr. Peck has not raised this issue before, he fails to allege that there is any good cause for his delay as required by NRS 34.726(1) because he does not claim how the government acted to conceal this information. As discussed, this Court has addressed many of Mr.

Peck's petitions in the past and the Court's orders frequently reference Chapter 34, belying Mr. Peck's claim this information was not readily available to him or that the government concealed the information. Accordingly, this claim is procedurally barred.

Mr. Peck has failed to demonstrate good cause or a fundamental miscarriage of justice sufficient to overcome the procedural bars to his ninth successive *Petition* and the *Petition* is summarily dismissed.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Mr. Peck's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) is SUMMARILY DENIED.


