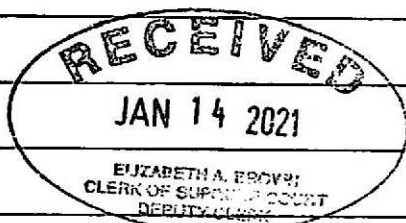

### 3. Fact


