**GEORGIA-PACIFIC GYPSUM LLC’S AND REPUBLIC
ENVIRONMENT TECHNOLOGIES, INC.’S NOTICE OF INTENT TO
FILE RESPONSES TO APPELLANT’S EMERGENCY MOTION FOR
STAY AND MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT**

Respondents Georgia-Pacific Gypsum LLC (“Georgia Pacific”) and Republic Environmental Technologies, Inc. (“Republic,” and collectively with Georgia-Pacific, “GP-R”), hereby file notice of their intent to file a response to Southern Nevada Water Authority’s (“SNWA”) Emergency Motion for Stay and SNWA’s Motion to Exceed Page Limit.

In its Emergency Motion for Stay, SNWA inappropriately asks this Court to review the merits of this appeal, providing 24 pages of substantive analysis on the dispositive issue in this appeal. This is not the intended purpose of a motion to stay, which NRAP 27(d)(2) appropriately limits to just 10 pages. SNWA’s attempt to circumvent the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure is wholly inappropriate—

especially because SNWA seeks to accelerate this Court’s ruling on its motion by designating it an “emergency.” As this Court is well aware, motions to exceed page limits are disfavored and “will not be routinely granted.” NRAP 27(a)(7). SNWA ignores this rule, and instead tries to manipulate the rules to present the dispositive question on appeal during the truncated motion practice. Its attempt should be rejected, for reasons explained more fully in GP-R’s forthcoming responses.
