DECLARATION OF NANCY M. LEMCKE

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada; I am the attorney appointed to represent Appellant ANDREW YOUNG in this appeal; and I am familiar with the procedural history of this case.
- 2. The instant Opening Brief derives from a 22-count felony jury trial in which approximately 17 witnesses testified for the prosecution. Mr. Young was convicted of all but two of the charged crimes. The trial court adjudicated him a habitual offender and sentenced him to, *inter alia*, nine consecutive sentences of life with the possibility of parole beginning after 10 years (for an aggregate total of 90 years to life in prison).
- 3. Given the nature and complexity of the charges and sentences, Mr. Young's case required extensive briefing.
- 4. The complexity of the briefing was compounded by the fact that none of the victims in the case could identify Mr. Young as a perpetrator; accordingly, it fell to law enforcement to attempt to identify him by other means, such as obtaining and narrating surveillance video.
- 5. Additionally, the trial court adjudicated Mr. Young a habitual criminal based upon several purported prior felony convictions. However, many of those convictions were very old, and the documentation supporting them was, at best, difficult to discern.

1	6. Effective presentation of these and other issues – and effective
2 3	articulation of the complicated facts required briefing in excess of that otherwise
4	allowed by NRAP 32(a)(7).
5	7. Accordingly, I am requesting that this Honorable Court grant
6 7	Appellant leave to submit the Opening Brief in excess of 14,000 words and 1,300
8	lines of text. The instant Opening Brief contains approximately 17,574 words and
9	1,725 lines of text.
