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issuance of the Amended Judgment of Conviction including crimes of conviction from each of the distinct trials.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Appellant was originally charged with several theft-related offenses as well as Attempt Murder with Use of a Deadly Weapon/Battery With Use of a Deadly Weapon Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm. After the District Court granted defense counsel's motion to sever the Attempt Murder/Battery charges from the theft-related offenses, Appellant proceeded to trial on the theft charges. He was convicted on all but two of those offenses. Following his sentencing, the District Court filed a Judgment of Conviction reflecting Appellant's convictions and corresponding sentences. Trial counsel then filed a timely Notice of Appeal (Nevada Supreme Court Case No. 83243).

Not long after, trial counsel withdrew from both of Appellant's matters – the pending appeal in Case No. 83243 as well as the severed Attempt Murder/Battery charges. The undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Appellant on the

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Attempt Murder/Battery charges; Nancy M. Lemcke, Esq. was appointed to represent Appellant in Case No. 83243.

While briefing on Case No. 83243 was pending, Appellant proceeded to trial on the Attempt Murder/Battery charges. A jury convicted Appellant of Battery with Use of a Deadly Weapon Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm. Thereafter, on the morning of March 8, 2022, Appellant filed his Opening Brief in Case No. 83243. Later that afternoon, the District Court filed an Amended Judgment of Conviction (JOC) adding the Battery conviction to the original JOC from which Case No. 83243 derived.

On the morning of March 21, 2022, Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal in the above-captioned matter, Nevada Supreme Court Case No. 84412, challenging Appellant's Battery with Use of a Deadly Weapon Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm conviction. This means that Appellant now has two cases pending before this Court – one for each set of severed charges – deriving from the same Amended JOC. Given that both matters are now pending separately before this Court; and given that both matters now derive from a single, amended JOC, the undersigned counsel is renewing Appellant's request, made previously in Case No. 83243, for instruction as to how to proceed with briefing. Specifically, Appellant

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3	matter or consolidate both into a single submission.
