## ORDER REGARDING TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM, DENYING MOTIONS, AND DIRECTING TRANSMISSION OF DOCUMENT

This is a pro se appeal from a district court order granting a motion to dismiss, motion for more definite statement, and motion to strike. Appellant, who is proceeding in forma pauperis, has filed a transcript request form pursuant to NRAP 9(b). At this stage of the proceedings, this court is unable to determine which transcripts, if any, are necessary for review on appeal, see NRAP 9(b)(1)(C), and therefore, declines to order the preparation of the requested transcripts at this time. However, as this appeal proceeds, this court will consider the necessity of transcripts and may order their preparation at a later date.

Appellant has also filed five pro se motions containing various requests for relief. All requests for relief in the motions are denied.


On December 19, 2022, this court entered an order directing the district court clerk to transmit to the clerk of this court a certified copy of the trial court record in the underlying district court case (A-22-856372-C). The order cited to NRAP 11(a)(2), which directs that the complete "record shall contain each and every paper, pleading and other document filed, or submitted for filing, in the district court . . . ." transmitted the record on appeal to this court on December 27, 2022, and January 3, 2023. However, the record does not include appellant's complaint. Accordingly, the district court clerk shall have 7 days from the date of this order to transmit to this court a copy of the complaint. If the district court clerk is unable to transmit this document, the clerk shall notify this court, in writing, within the same time period.
