DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS, MOTION FOR MORE DEFINITE STATEMENT, AND MOTION TO STRIKE

On September 16, 2022, Defendant received documents from the Nevada Supreme Court regarding an appeal filed in reference to Case No. A-22-856372-C and five other cases. Included in the documents received from the Supreme Court as a document titled "Emergency Notice Of Intention To enter Default(s)" referencing several civil and criminal District Court cases and multiple Supreme Court cases. Case No. A-22-856372-C was identified on the document.

Defendant states that he has not been served with a copy of the summons and complaint in Case No. A-22-856372-C, or any of the other cases referenced in Plaintiff's filing, but due to the intent to default Defendant, Defendant hereby moves this court for an order dismissing Plaintiff's Complaint in the above captioned matter pursuant to NRCP 12(b)(3), (4) and (5), for an order requiring Plaintiff to provide a more definite statement as to the basis for his claims pursuant to

NRCP 12(e), for an order striking the complaint pursuant to NRCP 12(f), and for an order compelling Plaintiff to comply with the "short and plain statement" requirement of NRCP 8(a) (2).

POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Plaintiff brings his frivolous action against Defendant with the intent to harass and in violation of NRCP 11(b).

Plaintiff Matthew Travis Houston, though his then legal counsel, the law firm Bernstein & Poisson, filed suit for personal injuries arising from a work place accident that occurred within the Mandalay Bay ballroom on September 30, 2016. (Civil case, Houston v. Mandalay Bay, Case No. A-17-758861-C, filed July 24, 2017.) While working as a high rigger for Encore Event Technologies, Mr. Houston unbooked his safety harness from rigging points in the ceiling of a ballroom at Mandalay Bay, then stepped out on to a false ceiling, falling more than 30 feet to the floor below. Mr. Houston was severely injured in the fall as a result of his own negligence.

On September 20, 2016, 10 days before his fall, Mr. Houston was arrested for felony DUI. Following his fall and head injuries, and several months after the fall, on June 9, 2017, Mr. Houston was found competent to stand trial for the September 20, 2016, DUI charges. Mr. Houston was placed in the court's "Serious Offender DUI Program", but was later terminated from the program due to 21 failures to be drug tested, and 6 failed drug tests. He was sentenced on the felony DUI and set to the High Desert Prison in Indian Springs to serve his sentence. (Criminal case number C-17-323614-1.)

While in prison on the felony DUI conviction, Mr. Houston's civil action related to the September 30, 2016 fall was proceeding. Mr. Houston, through his legal counsel, requested that Defendant Mandalay Bay participate in a mediation of Mr. Houston's action. At the May 17, 2019 mediation, Mr. Houston settled his claims against Mandalay Bay. Mr. Houston and his attorney signed the Mediation Settlement Agreement prepared by Mr. Houston's attorney. Additionally, Mr. Houston signed a Release Of All Claims And Agreement To Indemnify confirming the settlement.

In or about September 2019, Mr. Houston was released from jail and immediately fired his attorneys, Bernstein & Poisson, and attempted to set aside the settlement and reopen settlement negotiations. In January 2020, the District Court in Case No. A-17-758861-C entered an order enforcing the parties' settlement and dismissing Mr. Houston's action against Mandalay Bay. After the January 2020, order dismissing Mr. Houston's action, he filed 5 appeals with the Nevada Supreme Court related to District Court in Case No. A-17-758861-C (Supreme Court Case Nos. 80562, 84417, 84418, 84477, and 84887). Each appal has been addressed by, and dismissed by the Nevada Supreme Court. On August 9, 2022, in appeal number 84887, the Supreme Court made the following docket entry:

Filed Order Granting Motion to Stay Issuance of Remittitur. Appellant has filed an "emergency" pro se motion to stay the remittitur pending application to the Supreme Court of the United States for a writ of certiorari. The motion is granted. Issuance of the remittitur is stayed until November 30, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by November 30, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by November 30, 2022, the clerk shall issue the remittitur. (SC)

Remittiturs have issued on all other appeals.

On or about August 4, 2021, Mr. Houston entered a guilty plea to aggravated stalking, a felony, and he returned to prison. Mr. Houston plead guilty to a felony stalking charge whose victim(s) was/were employees of Mr. Houston's worker's compensation insurer from the September 30, 2016 incident where Mr. Houston unhooked from his safety rigging and fell 30 feet to the floor below.

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final judgment entered against him are void. In Re: Estate of Black, 132 Nev. 73, 75-76, 367 P.3d 416, 418 (2016) ("[D]efective service of process deprives a court of personal jurisdiction.")

C. NRCP 12(b)(5) -- Failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted.

NRCP 12(b)(5) specifically provides that the defense of "failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted" may be made by motion. *Gull v. Hoalst*, 77 Nev. 54, 59, 359 P.2d 383, 385 (1961); *Buzz Stew, LLC v. City of N. Las Vegas*, 124 Nev. 224, 227-228, 181 P.3d 670, 672 (2008). Such a motion tests the legal sufficiency of the claim set out against the moving party. "All factual allegations of the complaint must be accepted as true. A complaint will not be dismissed for failure to state a claim unless it appears beyond a doubt that the plaintiff could prove no set of facts which, if accepted by the trier of fact, would entitle him or her to relief." *Simpson v. Mars Inc.*, 113 Nev. 188, 190, 929 P.2d 966, 967 (1997), quoting from *Vacation Village v. Hitachi America*, 110 Nev. 481, 484, 874 P.2d 744, 746 (1994). Notwithstanding that all factual allegations of the complaint must be accepted as true, "A complaint must set forth sufficient facts to establish all necessary elements of a claim for relief, so that the adverse party has adequate notice of the nature of the claim and relief sought." *Hay v. Hay*, 100 Nev. 196, 198, 678 P.2d 672, 674 (1984).

A motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim should be granted when it appears beyond a doubt that plaintiff is entitled to no relief under any set of facts that could be proved in support of the claim. Buzz Stew, 124 Nev. at 228, 181 P.3d at 672 (citation omitted); Stockmeier v. Nevada Dept. Of Corr. Psychological Review Panel, 124 Nev. 313, 316, 183 P.3d 133, 135 (2008) (citation omitted). "Dismissal is proper where the allegations are insufficient to establish the elements of a claim for relief." Stockmeier, 124 Nev. at 316, 183 P.3d at 135, quoting Hampe v. Foote, 118 Nev. 405, 408, 47 P.3d 438, 439 (2002). If the proper showing is made by the movant, a motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim may be granted irrespective of the type of action involved or its complexity. See, e.g., Baldonado v. Wynn Las Vegas, LLC, 124 Nev. 951, 194 P.3d 96 (2008).

III. LEGAL STANDARD FOR A MORE DEFINITE STATEMENT UNDER NRCP 12(e).

The Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 12(e), provides for relief, prior to filing a responsive pleading, when a complaint is vague and ambiguous.

If a pleading to which a responsive pleading is permitted is so vague or ambiguous that a party cannot reasonably be required to frame a responsive pleading, the party may move for a more definite statement before interposing a responsive pleading. The motion shall point out the defects complained of and the details desired. If the motion is granted and the order of the court is not obeyed within 10 days after notice of the order or within such other time as the court may fix, the court may strike the pleading to which the motion was directed or make such order as it deems just.

(NRCP 12(e).)

IV. LEGAL STANDARD FOR A MOTION TO STRIKE UNDER NRCP 12(f).

The Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 12(f), provides for relief, prior to filing a responsive pleading, when a complaint contains redundant, immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matters.

The court may strike from a pleading an insufficient defense or any redundant, immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matter. The court may act:

- (1) on its own; or
- (2) on motion made by a party either before responding to the pleading or, if a response is not allowed, within 21 days after being served with the pleading.

 (NRCP 12(f).)

V. PLAINTIFF MUST BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A MORE DEFINITE STATEMENT ABOUT HIS CLAIMS AS THE COMPLAINT IS SO VAGUE AND AMBIGUOUS THAT DEFENDANT CANNOT REASONABLY BE REQUIRED TO FRAME A RESPONSIVE PLEADING.

Plaintiff filed an 82 page complaint against a single defendant. Parts of the complaint are hand written and other parts are printed pages, many appear to be taken from various sources without a citation to source. It is impossible to know was is part of the complaint and what might constitute an exhibit to support the complaint. According, a more definite statement must be provided before Defendant is required to submit a responsive pleading.

The court must order a more definite statement as the complaint is not properly formatted pursuant to NRCP 8(a). The rules of the court require that Plaintiff's pleading contain "(1) a short and plain statement of the grounds for the court's jurisdiction . . . ; (2) a short and plain statement of the claim showing that the pleader is entitled to relief; (3) a demand for the relief sought, which

Plaintiff has not served the summons and complaint. Defendant retrieved a copy of the "Complaint" from the court's website upon learning that a suit had been filed.

may include relief in the alternative or different types of relief; and (4) if the pleader seeks more than \$15,000 in monetary damages, the demand for relief may request damages "in excess of \$15,000" without further specification of the amount." (NRCP 8(a).) This 82 page (convoluted) document titled "Complaint(s) In Re Joinder(s) of Appeal" does not provide a short and plain statement to establish jurisdiction, show that the pleader is entitled to relief, does not identify the relief sought or the damages requested. Accordingly, a more definite statement must be provided before Defendant is required to submit a responsive pleading.

The complaint is not properly formatted pursuant to NRCP 10(b). The court's rules require that "A party must state its claims or defenses in numbered paragraphs, each limited as far as practicable to a single set of circumstances." (NRCP 10(b).) Accordingly, a more definite statement must be provided before Defendant is required to submit a responsive pleading.

Plaintiff's complaint is so vague as to be incomprehensible. Beginning on the second page of the complaint, (pages 2-4), Plaintiff inserts a form issued by the State Bar Of Nevada Office Of Bar Counsel titled "How to File a Complaint Against an Attorney." Plaintiff mistakenly uses this form as support for the mere mention of "legal malpractice in A-17-758861-C." (Complaint at p. 1, line 21.) Plaintiff's response on the form that he did not "hire/retain the attorney about whom you are complaining" creates vagueness and ambiguity about the entire document, requiring a more definite statement. (Complaint at p. 3, middle of the page.)

The title of the document also creates ambiguity about jurisdiction and the claims. Plaintiff's filing is titled "Complaint(s) In Re Joinder(s) of Appeal." (Complaint at p. 1.) The district court does not have jurisdiction to join Plaintiff's dismissed appeals (see above, at pp. 2-3 regarding Plaintiff's appeals) in Houston v. Mandalay Bay, Case No. A-17-758861-C, or the several appeals Mr. Houston has filed regarding his multiple criminal convictions. The title of the pleading creates sufficient ambiguity so as to require a more definite statement.

Plaintiff's complaint, and all of his filings with the court are subject to NRCP 11(b).

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- (b) Representations to the Court. By presenting to the court a pleading, written motion, or other paper—whether by signing, filing, submitting, or later advocating it—an attorney or unrepresented party certifies that to the best of the person's knowledge, information, and belief, formed after an inquiry reasonable under the circumstances:
- (1) it is not being presented for any improper purpose, such as to harass, cause unnecessary delay, or needlessly increase the cost of litigation;
- (2) the claims, defenses, and other legal contentions are warranted by existing law or by a nonfrivolous argument for extending, modifying, or reversing existing law or for establishing new law;
- (3) the factual contentions have evidentiary support or, if specifically so identified, will likely have evidentiary support after a reasonable opportunity for further investigation or discovery; and

(NRCP 11(b)(1) through (3).)

NRC P 11(b)(1) and (3), in conjunction with NRCP 12(e) require a more definite statement as to the statements in the complaint.

- 1. "This complaint alleges that Brian P. Clark paid Stephen Paddock, et al to do what they did to the Plaintiff. . .". (Complaint at p. 1, lines15-17.) Stephen Paddock is the October 1, 2017 shooter in the mass murders that occurred in Las Vegas on that date. Plaintiff, who is per se libeling Defendant with a horrendous crime and tragedy must be required to provide supporting facts of the alleged involvement of Defendant in the October 1, 2017 shooting, and the inferred conspiracy to do harm to Mr. Houston, and to identify what Stephen Paddock did to Plaintiff.
- 2. "Matthew Travis Houston, who is presently wrongfully convicted for the second time as result of Mr. Clark's civil and criminal acts not limited to conspiracy, coersion [sic], false imprisonment(s), extensive incarceration(s) and legal malpractice in A-17-758861-C." (Complaint at p. 1, lines 17-21.) Plaintiff must be required to provide supporting facts to establish each element of each cause of action. "A complaint must set forth sufficient facts to establish all necessary elements of a claim for relief, so that the adverse party has adequate notice of the nature of the claim and relief sought." Hay v. Hay, 100 Nev. 196, 198, 678 P.2d 672, 674 (1984).

- 3. Mr. Houston's "complaint" instructs the district court to "take notice" of a "renewed complaint" and attempts to order the district court to "consolidate every pleading from the Plaintiff within its's jurisdiction in the above mentioned cases". (Complaint at p. 1, lines 22-28.) A more definite statement must be ordered to allow the court and Defendant to understand the scope of Plaintiff's filing.
- 4. As part of the Nevada State Bar form title "How to File a Complaint Against An Attorney" (Complaint pp. 2-4), Plaintiff's hand writings are vague, ambiguous and lack the most basis factual allegations. "The events of my life being victim of Mr. Clark caused one October 2017, "Joey" the clown and two wrongful convictions, the theft of my dogs and of my person and the false arrests causing illegal destruction of my service and trained seeing-eye animals and 99 other problems from 3041 St. Rose Pkwy, not limited to \$36.5 million of my home(s) and other property destruction and C.P.T.S.D, 27 injuries and indefinite emotional distress." (Complaint at p. 4.) Addressing each:
 - a. Is it the "events of my life" or "Mr. Clark" that caused one October 2017?
 - b. Who, or what, is "Joey the clown"?
 - c. Wrongful criminal convictions would require an action against the district attorney and the court.
 - d. What are the *Hay v. Hay*, supra, facts to support the mere mention of the "theft of [his] dogs and [his] person?
 - e. False arrests would require an action against the agency that arrested Mr. Houston.
 - f. What are the *Hay v. Hay*, supra, facts to support the mere mention of the illegal destruction of Mr. Houston's service and trained seeing-eye animals?
 - g. What are the "99 other problems from 3041 St. Rose Pkwy"?
 - h. What is the \$36.5 million of my home(s) and other property destruction?
 - i. C.P.T.S.D.?
 - j. What are the "27 injuries and indefinite emotional distress"?

Plaintiff's complaint does not meet any of the minimal pleading requirements. The court must dismiss the complaint and order a more definite statement by Plaintiff's claims.

VI. PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT MUST BE STRICKEN UNDER NRCP 12(f) AS THE ENTIRE DOCUMENT CONSTITUTES REDUNDANT, IMMATERIAL, IMPERTINENT OR SCANDALOUS MATTER.

The Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 12(f), provides for relief, prior to filing a responsive pleading, when a complaint contains redundant, immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matters. As set forth above, the allegations of the complaint constitute scandalous material. Plaintiff's allegation that Defendant caused the October 1, 2017 shooting a Mandalay Bay is in fact scandalous, and libel *per se*.

Plaintiff's inclusion of a complaint to the State Bar of Nevada, on a form title "How to File a Complaint Against An Attorney" (Complaint pp. 2-4), does not constitute the short and plain statement requirement of NRCP 8(a). As a matter of law, Defendant as the opposing counsel in Plaintiff's personal injury action against Mandalay Bay for Plaintiff's September 30, 2016, industrial injury, owed no duty to Plaintiff and cannot be subject to a legal malpractice action brought by Mr. Houston. Defendant has never represented Mr. Houston.

After the work sheet "How to File a Complaint Against An Attorney" (Complaint pp. 2-4), the next fourteen pages of the complaint (with hand written designations "p. 13" to "p. 26") consist of an "*EMERGENCY PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS (POSTCONVICTION)*" related to a case titled "Matthew Travis Houston, Petitioner, v. Calvin Johnson, et al, Respondents" in Case No. C-21-357927-1. (See page designated "p. 13" at line 27, paragraph 4.) This petition for writ of habeas corpus in Mr. Houston's criminal proceedings constitutes immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matters in relation to the pending civil action. Plaintiffs' convoluted complaint does not infer or allege how the petition for writ of habeas corpus in a 2021 criminal matter is related to the pending civil action, and must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f).

Following the petition for writ of habeas corpus in Case No. C-21-357927-1, the next eleven pages of the complaint are titled "Direct Appeal" in Case No. C-21-357927-1. These issues on appeal to the Nevada Supreme Court cannot be addressed in this district court civil action. The district court in this civil action cannot undo or change what the other courts did that resulted in the

appeal, or what the Supreme Court ordered on appeal. (There are 2 mentions of ineffective aid of counsel, at pp. designated on the bottom as 33 and 37, but the information relates to Mr. Houston's criminal defense counsel.)

Following the "Direct Appeal" documents, Mr. Houston's complaint includes 1 page of a document titled "Renewed Mot. To Stay Remittitur". The document is clearly one that was, or should have been filed with the Nevada Supreme Court as it identifies Nevada Supreme Court case numbers 84477, 84478 and 84281. This document, included in the complaint has no relationship to this civil action and must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f).

Following the "Renewed Mot. To Stay Remittitur", Mr. Houston's complaint includes 9 pages titled, "Appellant's Informal Brief And Joinder Of Appeal" in Supreme Court cases 80652, 84477, 79408, 84281, 84417, 84478 and 84418. The document is clearly one that was filed with the Nevada Supreme Court. This document, included in the complaint, has no relationship to this civil action and must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f) as the district court has no jurisdiction to address the actions and decisions of the Nevada Supreme Court.

Following the "Appellant's Informal Brief And Joinder Of Appeal", Mr. Houston's complaint includes 9 pages titled "Appellant's Informal Brief And Joinder Of Appeal (Continued)." This is a different document than the previous pages. The document is clearly one that was filed, or should have been filed with, and addressed by, the Nevada Supreme Court. This document has no relationship to this civil action and must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f) as the district court has no jurisdiction to address the actions and decisions of the Nevada Supreme Court.

Following the "Appellant's Informal Brief And Joinder Of Appeal (Continued)", Mr. Houston's complaint includes 9 pages titled "Supplimental [sic] Petition To No. 84281 In The Supreme Court Of the State Of Nevada To Review The Nevada Court of Appeals Decision(s)". The sub-title of the document is "Joinder Of Appeal And Appellant's Informal Brief, Counterclaim and Emergency Mot. In Re Decision Of No. 84281 Filed 4/5/22." This document was presented to the Nevada Supreme Court in relation to multiple appeals filed by Mr. Houston from civil and criminal cases. These documents must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f) as they are redundant of claims resolved by the Nevada Supreme Court, are immaterial and unrelated to new claims that might be

included in Mr. Houston's complaint, are impertinent to the district court's present inquiry about jurisdiction, and are scandalous as the hodgepodge phrases in the complaint could be construed to allege that Defendant was involved in the murder of 60 persons and wounding 413 persons.

The page that follows the pages titled "Supplimental [sic] Petition To No. 84281 In The Supreme Court Of the State Of Nevada To Review The Nevada Court of Appeals Decision(s)" is a printed page titled "Things to Consider When Making a Motion for Transport of Inmate for Court Appearance." There is nothing on this page that contains any information to clarify Plaintiff's convoluted complaint. This document must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f) as it is immaterial and unrelated to the claims that might be inferred in Mr. Houston's complaint, and is impertinent to the district court's present inquiry about jurisdiction.

The next two (2) pages of Mr. Houston's complaint, "Affirmation" and "Certificate Of Service By Mailing" (pages designated as "p.68" "p.69") cannot be related to this action, as Plaintiff signed these documents on July 10, 2022, 24 days before he filed the complaint. The certificate of service, alleging that service was made by mail more than 3 weeks before the complaint was filed, an admission that Defendant was not served, establish that these documents must be stricken pursuant to NRCP 12(f) as the alleged service is a fraud on the court. Plaintiff cannot serve a complaint before it is filed. Plaintiff cannot serve a complaint my mail, and the alleged service does not include the Defendant.

The remaining 22 pages of Plaintiff's complaint are incomplete documents, many of which were filed in relation to Mr. Houston's appeals, provide no additional information to identify or support any claim against Defendant in the present action. It appears that Plaintiff just added more paper to the filing, likely to increase girth rather than facts or substance.

VII. PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT MUST BE DISMISSED DUE TO INSUFFICIENT PROCESS PURSUANT TO NRCP 12(b)(3).

On August 30, 2022, Plaintiff mailed Defendant a document titled "Summons". The document appears to be the first page of Plaintiff's complaint with the word "SUMMONS" written across the top. This summons was not issued by the court, was not served with the complaint, and does not contain the information required by NRCP 4(a)(1)(B, D, E, F, and G).

1	(a) Summons.
2	(1) Contents. A summons must:
3	(A) name the court, the county, and the parties;
4	(B) be directed to the defendant;
5 6	(C) state the name and address of the plaintiff's attorney or—if unrepresented—of the plaintiff;
7	(D) state the time within which the defendant must appear and defend under Rule 12(a) or any other applicable rule or statute;
9	(E) notify the defendant that a failure to appear and defend will result in a default judgment against the defendant for the relief demanded in the complaint;
10	(F) be signed by the clerk;
11	(G) bear the court's seal; and
12	(H) comply with Rule 4.4(c)(2)(C) when service is made by publication.
13	The court cannot exercise personal jurisdiction over Defendant when there has been
14	insufficient process. Accordingly, Plaintiff's case must be dismissed.
15 16	VIII. PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT MUST BE DISMISSED FOR INSUFFICIENT SERVICE OF PROCESS.
17	Plaintiff has failed to serve a copy of the summons and complaint on Defendant as required
18	by court rules. NRCP 4.2(a) identifies the method of service upon an individual.
19	(a) Serving an Individual. Unless otherwise provided by these rules, service may be made on an individual:
20	(1) by delivering a copy of the summons and complaint to the individual
21	personally;
22	(2) by leaving a copy of the summons and complaint at the individual's dwelling or usual place of abode with a person of suitable age and discretion who
23	currently resides therein and is not an adverse party to the individual being served; or
24	(3) by delivering a copy of the summons and complaint to an agent authorized by appointment or by law to receive service of process.
25	
26	Defendant was first informed of Plaintiff's suit in on September 1, 2022 when Defendant
27	received Plaintiff's August 30, 2022 mailing. Defendant has not been served with Plaintiff's
28	complaint in any manner and has not consented to service by mail.

IX. PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT SHOULD BE DISMISS FOR FAILURE TO STATE A CLAIM PURSUANT TO NRCP 12(b)(5).

Plaintiff's complaint must be dismissed as it (1) does not properly identify any cause of action, and (2) does not satisfy the pleading requirements of *Hay v. Hay*, 100 Nev. 196, 198, 678 P.2d 672, 674 (1984), that "A complaint must set forth sufficient facts to establish all necessary elements of a claim for relief, so that the adverse party has adequate notice of the nature of the claim and relief sought." "Dismissal is proper where the allegations are insufficient to establish the elements of a claim for relief." *Stockmeier v. Nevada Dept. Of Corrections Psychological Review Panel*, 124 Nev. 313, 316, 183 P.3d at 135, quoting *Hampe v. Foote*, 118 Nev. 405, 408, 47 P.3d 438, 439 (2002).

X. CONCLUSION.

Plaintiff's complaint has not been served. Plaintiff's "summons" is defective and has not been served pursuant to NRCP 4(a) and NRCP 4.2.

Plaintiff's complaint does not comply with NRCP 8, "(1) a short and plain statement of the grounds for the court's jurisdiction . . . ; (2) a short and plain statement of the claim showing that the pleader is entitled to relief; (3) a demand for the relief sought, which may include relief in the alternative or different types of relief; and (4) if the pleader seeks more than \$15,000 in monetary damages, the demand for relief may request damages "in excess of \$15,000" without further specification of the amount."

Plaintiff's complaint does not comply with NRCP 10(b)'s requirement that "A party must state its claims or defenses in numbered paragraphs, each limited as far as practicable to a single set of circumstances."

Plaintiff's complaint is completely defective and lacking in facts such that Defendant cannot formulate a responsive pleading, thus requiring dismissal and a more definite statement.


In support of this Motion, I allege the following:

- 1. I am an inmate incarcerated at High Desert State Prison.

 My mandatory release date is September 29, 2025.
- 2. The Department of Corrections is required to transport offenders to and from Court if an inmate is required or requests to appear before a Court in this state.

NRS 209.274 Transportation of Offender to Appear Before Court states:

- "1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, when an offender is required or requested to appear before a Court in this state, the Department shall transport the offender to and from Court on the day scheduled for his appearance.
- 2. If notice is not provided within the time set forth in NRS 50.215, the Department shall transport the offender to Court on the date scheduled for his appearance if it is possible to transport the offender in the usual manner for the transportation of offenders by the Department. If it is not possible for the Department to transport the offender in the usual manner:
- (a) The Department shall make the offender available on the date scheduled for his appearance to provide testimony by telephone or by video conference, if so requested by the Court.
- (b) The Department shall provide for special transportation of the offender to and from the Court, if the Court so orders. If the Court orders special transportation, it shall order the county in which the Court is located to reimburse the Department for any cost incurred for the special transportation.
- (c) The Court may order the county sheriff to transport the offender to and from the Court at the expense of the county."
- 3. My presence is required at the hearing because:



I AM NEEDED AS A WITNESS.

My petition raises substantial issues of fact concerning events in which I participated and about which only I can testify. See U.S. v. Hayman, 342 U.S. 205 (1952) (District Court erred when it made findings of fact concerning Hayman's knowledge and consent to his counsel's representation of a witness against Hayman without notice to Hayman or Hayman's presence at the evidentiary hearing).

THE HEARING WILL BE AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING.

My petition raises material issues of fact that can be determined only in my presence. See Walker v. Johnston, 312 U.S. 275 (1941) (government's contention that allegations are improbable and unbelievable cannot serve to deny the petitioner an opportunity to support them by evidence). The Nevada Supreme Court has held that the presence of the petitioner for habeas corpus relief is required at any evidentiary hearing conducted on the merits of the claim asserted in the petition. See Gebers v. Nevada, 118 Nev. 500 (2002).

- 4. The prohibition against ex parte communication requires that I be present at any hearing at which the state is present and at which issues concerning the claims raised in my petition are addressed. U.S. Const. amends. V, VI.
- 5. If a person incarcerated in a state prison is required or is requested to appear as a witness in any action, the Department of Corrections must be notified in writing not less than 7 business days before the date scheduled for his appearance in Court if the inmate is incarcerated in a prison located not more than 40 miles from Las Vegas. NRS 50.215(4). If a person is incarcerated in a prison located 41 miles or more from Las Vegas, the Department of Corrections must be notified in writing not less than 14 business days before the date scheduled for the person's appearance in Court.
 - 6. High Desert State Prison is located approximately

 miles from Las Vegas, Nevada.

7. If there is insufficient time to provide the required notice to the Department of Corrections for me to be transported to the hearing, I respectfully request that this Honorable Court order the Warden to make me available on the date of the scheduled appearance, by telephone, or video conference, pursuant to NRS 209.274(2)(a), so that I may provide relevant testimony and/or be present for the evidentiary hearing.

The Nevada Supreme Court has held that the presence of the petitioner for habeas corpus relief is required at any evidentiary hearing conducted on the merits of the claim asserted in the petition. See Gebers v. Nevada, 118 Nev. 500 (2002).

- 4. The prohibition against ex parte communication requires that I be present at any hearing at which the state is present and at which issues concerning the claims raised in my petition are addressed. U.S. Const. amends, V, VI.
- 5. If a person incarcerated in a state prison is required or is requested to appear as a witness in any action, the Department of Corrections must be notified in writing not less than 7 business days before the date scheduled for his appearance in Court if the inmate is incarcerated in a prison located not more than 40 miles from Las Vegas. NRS 50.215(4). If a person is incarcerated in a prison located 41 miles or more from Las Vegas, the Department of Corrections must be notified in writing not less than 14 business days before the date scheduled for the person's appearance in Court.
- 6. High Desert State Prison is located approximately

 miles from Las Vegas, Nevada.

- 7. If there is insufficient time to provide the required notice to the Department of Corrections for me to be transported to the hearing, I respectfully request that this Honorable Court order the Warden to make me available on the date of the scheduled appearance, by telephone, or video conference, pursuant to NRS 209.274(2)(a), so that I may provide relevant testimony and/or be present for the evidentiary hearing.
- 8. The rules of the institution prohibit me from placing telephone calls from the institution, except for collect calls, unless special arrangements are made with prison staff. Nev. Admin. Code DOC 718.01. However, arrangements for my telephone appearance can be made by contacting the following staff member at my institution: Calvin Johnson Warden whose telephone number is (702) 879-6789

on January 30,2020, this court heard the Plaintiff Matthew Travis Houston . Phintiff

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on October 13th, 2021 wrote BERNSTRINK POISSON a letter and sent him a copy of the Criminal Court Minutes and the Order Granting Plaintiff 's Motion for Withdrawl of Attorney of Record and Transfer of Records. See the transcripts and dockets.

As of the date of this motion, Plaintiff has not received any response from Mr. Poisson or the transfer of records that was requested.

ARGUMENT

Nevada Courts have the inherent power and jurisdiction to impose sanctions on attorneys. even in crimnal cases. See Supreme Court Rules, Rule 39, and also, Young v. Ninth Judicial District Court, 107 Nev. 652, 818 P.2d 844 (1991); and, Greene v. State, 113 Nev. 157 at 170, 931 P.2d 54 (1997). Plaintiff 's Direct Appeal was decided on 10/26/2021 Mr. Possson did not send the the file to the Plaintiff upon the Supreme Courts Decision to deny the appeal. Nevada Revised Statute chapter 34 sets forth the procedures to be utilized by a person convicted of a crime to collaterally attack their conviction. NRS 34.726 requires that the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-Conviction) be filed within one (1) year of the date of the remittitur issuing in the case. Mr. Poisson has not forwarded the file to Plaintiff when his representation was complete upon the denial Of the Direct Appeal and even after this Court has ordered him to forward the file to the Plaintiff 111

1 SCR 154(1) requires an attorney to keep a client reasonably informed about the status of a matter and to promptly comply with a reasonable request for information. As shown by the Court's 3 Orders of A-17-758861-Comm. Poisson has not promptly responded to Plaintiff's request for his case file so that the Petitioner can competently challenge his conviction in the Courts. 6 The Nevada Supreme Court has adopted the standard set forth 7 in Strickland v. Washington, 104 S.Ct. 2052, 466 U.S. 668 (1984), for judging the reasonable effective assistance of counsel. See Warden v. Lyons, 683 P.2d 504, 100 Nev. 430 (1984); Dawson v. 10 State, 825 P.2d 593, 108 Nev. 112 (1992). 11 Strickland, requires that a convicted defendant making a 12 claim of ineffective assistance of counsel must identify the acts 13 or omissions of counsel that are alleged not to have been the 14 result of proffessional judgment. Id., 104 S.Ct. at 2066 n.12. 15 Without the requested file, Plaintiff cannot identify all of 16 acts and ommissions of counsel. He is in essence in a boat without 17 a paddle and no way to steer a course. Without the file, Plaintiff-18 Petitioner can do no more than make bare allegations. 19 SCR 166(4) requires that upon termination of representation **2**Ö the attorney shall take reasonable steps to protect a client's 21 interests, including surrender papers and property to which the client is entitled. See <u>In re Kaufman</u>, 93 Nev. 452, 567 P.2d 957 23 (1977); and, <u>In re Frankovich</u>, 94 Nev. 104 at 109, 575 P.2d 931 24 (1978). 25 Scott L. Poisson clearly has failed in his obligations to the 26 Plaintiff in not forwarding his file to him upon the termination 27 of representation. He can not claim that he is unaware of the

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Supreme Court Rules which define and determine the conduct of 2 all attorneys in the State of Nevada. He was notified of the Court's Order by the District Attorney's Office, and he received a letter with a copy of the Court's Order from the Plaintiff. He has completely ignored and refused to com ply with the Supreme Court Rules and Order of this Court. For those reasons Mr. Poisson should be censured by this Court imposing a fine/ imprisonment of 48 hours and made to comply with this Courts Order. CONCLUSION WHEREFORE all of the above stated reasons, Plaintiff requests this Honorable Court find Mr. Poisson in contempt and impose a sanction that will insure futer compliance with this Court's Orders and make him comply with the present order. - Defendant filed a Motion to Dismiss, Motion for More Definite Statement, and Motion to Strike on September 21, 2022. The matter was subsequently scheduled for hearing on October 27, 2022.

No opposition having been filed and good cause showing, pursuant to EDCR 2.20(e) and EDCR 2.23(c) the Court hereby GRANTS Defendant's Motion.

Specifically, the Court finds that Plaintiff's Complaint does not properly identify any cause of action, nor does the Complaint satisfy the pleading requirements of NRCP 8(a). Instead, a review of Plaintiff's Complaint shows that it is a compilation of various court documents and filings, which include, among other things, a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Post-conviction), a direct appeal to the Nevada Supreme Court for Case No. C-21-357927-1, and a Motion for the Production of Records from Las Vegas Fire and Rescue. While the Court recognizes that Plaintiff is proceeding pro se, "a pro se litigant cannot use his alleged ignorance as a shield to protect him from the consequences of failing to comply with basic procedural requirements." Rodriguez v. Fiesta Palms, LLC, 134 Nev. 654, 659, 428 P.3d 255, 259 (2018). Consequently, the Court GRANTS Defendant"s Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint.

The Court hereby VACATES the October 27, 2022 hearing and all future hearing dates in this matter.
