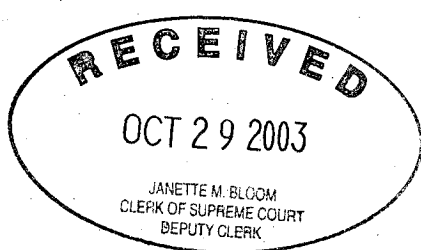

DEFT'S PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS - BROWN...TRIAL SETTING

Court advised it sees two basic aspects - 1) asportation of the underlying offense and 2) question of increase danger to pursue alleged kidnapping to person or persons; it has doubts to this restraint not being incidental to robbery and asked Ms. DeLaGarza to work a hypothetical with the Court. Ms. DeLaGarza advised the defts bound the victims. Court asked where is the charge that the beating would justify. Ms. DeLaGarza advised kidnapping included bodily harm, and this binding was not just incidental to robbery. Mr. Fritz stated it deals with kidnapping and robbery, people were not kidnapped to be harmed but to be robbed. Court asked what is the separate offense. Ms. DeLaGarza advised the kidnapping is it's own offense charge and these victims sustained bodily harm. Mr. Fritz advised they say it's a robbery case and he thinks it's right on point with the Wright case. Court advised it should be left to the jury as to robbery. COURT ORDERED, Deft Brown's Petition for Writ is DENIED. Mr. Fritz advised we needed to set a trial date. Ms. DeLaGarza advised deft. Black invoked and deft. Brown waived. COURT ORDERED, matter set for trial in 60 days. Trial date given due to request of the State. Mr. Fritz inquired about standard bail. Opposition by Ms. DeLaGarza. Court directed counsel to put bail request in a written motion.


