This is an appeal from an order of the district court denying appellant's post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus in a capital case. Appellant has filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file the opening brief. Good cause appearing, we grant the motion. SCR 250(7)(d) (on appeal from a judgment or order resolving an application for a post-conviction relief in a capital case, supreme court may grant an extension of up to 60 days on showing of good cause).
