MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE
APPELLANT'S REPLY BRIEF

COMES NOW the Appellant, SAMUEL HOWARD, by and through his pro bono counsel, Patricia M. Erickson, and respectfully requests this Court enter an order, pursuant to N.R.A.P. 26(b) to extend the time in which to file Appellant's Reply Brief. 2. On August 10, 2004, undersigned counsel, who is also counsel in the federal case entitled <u>United States of America v. Ricardo Figueroa</u> case no. CR-S-03-235-RCJ(PAL), learned that Mr. Figueroa was not going to accept the very favorable negotiations offered in the case and was set upon going to trial. Undersigned counsel was very surprised by Mr. Figueroa's decision to decline the offered negotiations as they were so favorable and has had to expend a significant amount of time preparing for this trial which is firmly scheduled to commence on August 31, 2004 before the Honorable R. Clive Jones. This trial is anticipated to take four (4) days to complete.

3. As undersigned counsel is required to begin trial on August 31, 2004 in the federal case entitled <u>United States v. Ricardo Figueroa</u>, case no. CR-S-03-235-RCJ(PAL) which is anticipated to take four (4) days, has oppositions due to be filed in the capital trial entitled <u>State of Nevada v. Doneale Feazell</u>, case no. C110711 on September 10, 2004, and will be out of the country from September 18, 2004 through October 2, 2004, it is respectfully requested that this Honorable Court allow undersigned counsel until October 11, 2004 to file the Reply Brief in the above entitled matter.

6. It is respectfully requested that the requested additional time is necessary for undersigned counsel to adequately and effectively protect Mr. HOWARD's Fifth Amendment right to due process of law and his Sixth Amendment right to effective assistance of counsel.
