MOTION TO CONTINUE ORAL ARGUMENT SET FOR JUNE 13, 2006

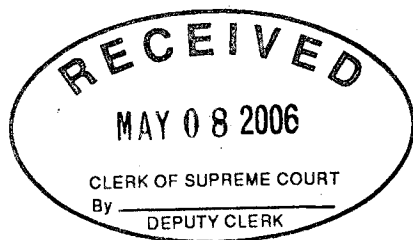

POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Rule 34. Oral Argument

- (a) Notice of argument; postponement. The clerk shall advise all parties of the time and place at which oral argument will be heard, and whether argument will be before the full court or a panel. A request for postponement of the argument must be made by motion reasonably in advance of the date fixed for hearing.

The undersigned is scheduled to begin a murder trial State of Nevada v. Myrdus Archie, C196420, which has been continued several times and is scheduled to proceed on June 12, 2006. Ms. Archie's co-defendant faces a penalty of death. The undersigned believes Ms. Archie's case will proceed to trial as scheduled. Ms. Archie's trial is expected to last approximately two (2) weeks. Therefore, the oral argument may be set anytime after June 26, 2006. The undersigned notifies this Court well in advance. The undersigned apologizes for any inconvenience this may have caused.


