ORDER STAYING REMITTITUR

Appellant Donte Johnson has moved to stay issuance of the remittitur until March 26, 2007, pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. If such notice is not received by April 9, 2007, the remittitur shall issue on April 10, 2007.
