The State charged Budd with three counts of Open Murder with Use of a Deadly Weapon. Budd plead not guilty. The State filed a Notice of Intent to Seek the Death Penalty. The case proceeded to trial and the jury convicted Budd of three Counts of First Degree Murder With Use of a Deadly Weapon. After a penalty hearing, the jury sentenced Budd to life without the possibility of parole for each count. The district court ordered the counts to be served consecutively.


