ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Appellant Steven Floyd Voss was convicted in November of 1996, pursuant to a jury verdict, of one count of burglary, one count of attempted theft, two counts of uttering a forged instrument, and two counts of forgery. On March 11, 1999, this court entered an order dismissing his direct appeal. The remittitur issued on April 6, 1999. On March 31, 2006, almost six years after issuance of the remittitur, appellant submitted a proper person motion requesting this court to recall the remittitur in the appeal. On April 28, 2006, this court entered an order denying the motion.


Appellant has now submitted a proper person motion for reconsideration and rehearing of the order denying his request to recall remittitur. Appellant has failed to demonstrate any valid or legally cognizable basis for recalling the remittitur at this late date. The decision resolving appellant's direct appeal is final, and the docket in this case has been closed. The clerk of this court shall return to appellant unfiled any further proper person documents submitted in this

docket. Appellant's request for reconsideration and rehearing is hereby denied.
