
ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS AND DIRECTING FULL BRIEFING

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a jury verdict, of one count of voluntary manslaughter with the use of a deadly weapon and one count of sexual penetration of a dead human body. On March 16, 2007, counsel for appellant filed a motion for full briefing of this appeal. This court has concluded that full briefing of this appeal is warranted, and the motion is therefore granted. Accordingly, counsel for the parties shall fully brief the issues as provided in NRAP 28, 28A, 30, 31 and 32.

On March 19, 2007, court recorder Lisa Lizotte filed a motion for an extension of time in which to file the transcripts in this appeal. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. Lizotte shall have 45 days from the date of this order within which to file the requested transcripts. Appellant shall have 120 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with the schedule set forth in NRAP 31.

Finally, on April 16, 2007, counsel for appellant filed a motion to suspend the deadlines for the filing of documents pursuant to NRAP 3C. In light of this order, the motion is denied as moot.

It is so ORDERED.
