
## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

## <u>ORDER</u>

Appellant has filed a motion for leave to file a 53-page opening brief. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. NRAP 28(g). The clerk shall file the opening brief and appendix received on December 4, 2007.

Additionally, appellant has filed a "Motion to Transmit Exhibit for Court's Consideration." Specifically, appellant seeks an order directing the district court to transmit Exhibit 125A (a redacted audio tape recording) to this court for its consideration in this appeal. Cause appearing, we grant the motion. <u>See</u> NRAP 30(d). The clerk of the district court shall, within 20 days of the date of this order, certify and transmit to this court the original redacted audio tape recording, admitted into evidence as Exhibit 125A.<sup>1</sup>
