ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE RESPONSE

This is an appeal from a district court order granting judicial review and reversing an administrative hearing officer's decision upholding appellant Department of Motor Vehicle's (DMV) denial of respondent's application to renew his personalized license plate.

On March 3, 2009, we issued an order to show cause to the DMV, directing them to address the issue of mootness by informing this court as to whether the license plate at issue on appeal is currently registered to respondent William Junge. The DMV has timely responded to our order to show cause.

Currently before this court is amicus curiae American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada's (ACLUN) unopposed motion to allow the ACLUN to file a response to this court's show cause order. Cause appearing, we grant the motion. Accordingly, we direct the clerk of this court to file the ACLUN's response to our show cause order, which is attached to the ACLUN's motion.¹
