ORDER REGARDING TRANSCRIPTS

On July 12, 2007, appellant filed a transcript request form requesting court reporters Bill Nelson and Lee Bahr to produce the transcripts of proceedings held on February 8, 2007, and April 5, 2007, respectively. The requested transcripts were due to be filed by August 13, 2007. NRAP 9(b) and 26(a). Neither Mr. Nelson nor Ms. Bahr filed the transcripts. Accordingly, on November 20, 2007, this court entered an order applying the amended version of NRAP 9(b) to the requested transcripts and directing Mr. Nelson and Ms. Bahr to file certificates acknowledging delivery of the transcripts within 20 days.

To date, neither Mr. Nelson nor Ms. Bahr has filed a certificate of delivery as directed in our order of November 20, 2007. Mr. Nelson and Ms. Bahr shall have 20 days from the date of this order to file a certificate acknowledging that the requested transcripts have been prepared, filed in the district court and delivered to the requesting party. See NRAP 9(b). If more time is needed to complete the preparation of the transcripts, Mr. Nelson and Ms. Bahr shall within the same time period, file a motion requesting an extension of time and stating the reason for the extension. See NRAP 9(c). If a requested transcript cannot be

produced, the responsible court reporter shall notify this court, in writing, of this fact.

It is so ORDERED.
