ORDER REGARDING TRANSCRIPTS

On November 20, 2007, this court entered an order which among other things, directed court reporter Bill Nelson to file a certificate in this court by December 10, 2007, acknowledging that the transcript of proceedings held on February 8, 2007, was prepared, filed in the district court and delivered to the requesting party.<sup>1</sup> As the certificate was not timely filed, on January 18, 2008, this court entered an order directing Mr. Nelson to file the certificate by February 7, 2008.


To date, Mr. Nelson has failed to file the required certificate or otherwise communicate with this court. A review of the district court docket entries indicates that the requested transcript was filed in the district court on January 4, 2008. Further, it appears that Mr. Nelson delivered a copy of the requested transcript to counsel for appellant as the transcript is included in the appendix to the opening brief. Mr. Nelson is strongly admonished for his failure to comply with our November 20, 2007, and January 18, 2008, orders and cautioned that failure to comply with future orders of this court may result in the imposition of sanctions. this instance only, because it appears that Mr. Nelson has prepared the transcript, filed it in district court and delivered a copy to the requesting party, we elect to waive Mr. Nelson's responsibility to file a certificate acknowledging delivery of the requested transcript.
