

ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND CONDITIONALLY IMPOSING SANCTIONS

On September 2, 2008, appellant filed a motion for a third extension of time to file the opening brief. In support of the motion, counsel for appellant states that the transcript of proceedings held on December 5, 2007, has not yet been filed. Extreme and unforeseeable circumstances having been shown, appellant's motion is granted to the following extent. NRAP 31(a)(1). Appellant shall have 60 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix.

On January 22, 2008, appellant filed a transcript request form requesting court reporter Kim Tuchman (now Kim Walker-Tuchman) to produce the transcript of proceedings held on December 5, 2007. A certificate acknowledging delivery of the requested transcript was due to be filed by March 3, 2008. <u>See</u> NRAP 9(b).¹ As Ms. Walker-Tuchman failed to file the certificate of delivery, on April 17, 2008, this court entered an order directing Ms. Walker-Tuchman to file the certificate by May 19, 2008. However, the order was returned to this court as undeliverable.

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA After the clerk obtained an updated address for Ms. Walker-Tuchman, this court, on August 25, 2008, entered an order directing Ms. Walker-Tuchman to file the certificate of delivery by September 4, 2008.

To date, Ms. Walker-Tuchman has failed to file the requested The failure of a party, or of an officer of this court, to file certificate. documents that are essential to the efficient processing of an appeal deprives the parties of a prompt resolution of their case. See Dougan v. <u>Gustaveson</u>, 108 Nev. 517, 523, 835 P.2d 795, 799 (1992) (recognizing this court's commitment to the proposition that "justice delayed is justice denied"); NRAP 13(a) (a person serving as a court reporter in a trial or hearing subject to Supreme Court review is, for such purposes, an officer of the Supreme Court and accountable to that court for the faithful performance of their duties). Consequently, this court has declared in the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure that the failure to pay the filing fee, or to file a case appeal statement, docketing statement, transcript request form, transcripts, or briefs in a timely manner, may be grounds for the imposition of sanctions. See NRAP 3(a); NRAP 9(c); NRAP 13(b); NRAP 14(c).

We conclude that Ms. Walker-Tuchman's failure to file a certificate acknowledging delivery of the December 5, 2007, transcript in compliance with the court's procedural rules and the order issued in this matter warrants the *conditional* imposition of sanctions. Accordingly, Ms. Walker-Tuchman shall, within 15 days from the date of this order, pay the sum of \$250.00 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment. However, this sanction shall be automatically vacated if Ms. Walker-Tuchman files a certificate acknowledging delivery

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA of the December 5, 2007, transcript or, alternatively, a motion to extend time, within ten days from the date of this order.²

It is so ORDERED.
