## ORDER VACATING SANCTIONS

On September 26, 2008, this court entered an order conditionally imposing sanctions on court reporter Kim Walker-Tuchman for her failure to file a certificate acknowledging delivery of the transcript requested of her on January 22, 2008. That order directed Ms. Walker-Tuchman to provide this court with proof of payment of the sanctions by October 13, 2008. Our order stated that the sanctions would be automatically vacated if Ms. Walker-Tuchman filed the certificate of delivery by October 6, 2008.

Ms. Walker-Tuchman is admonished for failing to comply with our September 26, 2008, order. Nevertheless, in this instance only, we elect to vacate the sanctions imposed in our September 26, 2008, order.
