DECLARATION OF AUDREY M. CONWAY

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada; I am a deputy public defender assigned to handle the appeal of this matter; I am familiar with the procedural history of this case.
- 2. That the Opening Brief was due to be filed on or before Tuesday, November 25, 2008. This Court has granted previous extensions due to delays in receipt of transcripts.
- 3. That appellate staff received the last of the documentation needed to finalize the appendix at the end of October. The final transcript was not filed until October 17, 2008, and received by this office the following week. In addition, appellate staff located an additional box of materials related to this file that had only recently been forwarded from the main office. Appellate staff needed at least two additional weeks to incorporate the documentation into the appendix, finalize the index, and deliver the appendix to declarant.
- 4. The final appendix will be completed by the end of November. The appendix consists of three volumes of at least 250 pages each.
