17	this affidavit are true.	
18	1. I am an attorney, duly licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada. As such, I am

20	employed as a Chief Deputy in the appellate division of the Washoe County Public Defender's	
21	Office. In that capacity I represent Petitioner, Siaosi Vanisi, in an Original Petition for Writ of	
22	Certiorari or Mandamus and Request for Emergency Stay of Trial Pending Resolution of the	
23	Issues Herein, which is being filed together with the instant Motion;

That the Original Petition filed herewith challenges a lower court's Order Under Seal denying Petitioner's counsels' motion to withdraw which was filed under seal in the Second Judicial District Court, case number CR98-0516, department 4;

3. That because the order the subject matter of the Petition is under seal, it was not attached to the Petition (or specifically discussed) because such acts would constitute a violation of the sealed order as noted in the concluding pages of the Petition;

4. That similarly, the sealed portion of the transcript of the hearing held on August 26, 1999, concerning the motion to withdraw was not included (nor cited to) in the Petition because such acts would constitute a violation of the order sealing the transcript (in fact Petitioner's counsel does not even have a copy of that portion of the transcript); and further Petitioner's counsel needs a copy of the sealed transcript to assist in preparation of points and authorities in support of the writ;

5. That, accordingly, this Court should order the district court to deliver to Petitioner's counsel *only*, that sealed portion of the transcript of the hearing held on August 26, 1999;

6. That Petitioner's counsel seeks leave to file in-camera or under seal with this Court points and authorities in support of the Petition, and further seeks permission to file such points and authorities without having to deliver a copy to the counsel for the Real Party In Interest, and further seeks guidance from this Court on how to accomplish this task;

7. That this Court needs both the Order Under Seal, filed on August 30, 1999, and the sealed portion of the transcript of the hearing held on August 26, 1999, to assist in its full and complete review of the proceedings below, and thus, this Court should order the district court
