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MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time prescribed by the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for doing any act, or may permit an act to be done after the expiration of such time. In addition, this is a death penalty case and Supreme Court Rule 250(7)(d) allows for an initial extension of time of up to sixty (60) days upon showing of good cause.
