ORDER RECALLING REMITTITUR

Respondent has filed a motion to stay issuance of the remittitur in this case for 120 days pending its application to the United States Supreme Court for a writ of certiorari. Appellant has filed a notice of non-opposition to this motion. Because the remittitur for this case had already issued on August 24, 2010, prior to the filing of respondent's motion, we deny the motion as moot. We have nonetheless determined that the remittitur for this case should be recalled in light of respondent's petition to the United States Supreme Court. Accordingly, we recall the remittitur issued by this court on August 24, 2010. Thereafter, the reissuance of the remittitur shall be stayed for 120 days.
