ORDER REGARDING TRANSCRIPTS AND GRANTING MOTION IN PART

Appellant has filed a motion for a 60-day extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix. In support of the motion, appellant explains that he has not yet received transcripts for the district court proceedings conducted on the following dates: April 10, 2008; April 11, 2008; April 14-18, 2008; and April 21, 2008.

Upon review of the district court minutes, it is not clear that these transcripts are necessary for this court's review of this appeal. See NRAP 9(a) ("Counsel have a duty to confer and attempt to reach an agreement concerning the transcripts necessary for the Supreme Court's

review on appeal."); NRAP 10(b) ("For the purposes of appeal, the parties shall submit to the Supreme Court . . . copies of all transcripts necessary to the Supreme Court's review, as appendices to their briefs."); NRAP 30(b)(1) ("Copies of all transcripts that are necessary to the Supreme Court's review of the issues presented on appeal shall be included in the appendix."). In particular, appellant pleaded guilty on March 28, 2008. It appears that he thereafter testified against his codefendant, Narcus Wesley. According to this court's review of the district court minutes, there were no proceedings involving appellant during April 2008; rather, the requested transcripts identified above appear to be for proceedings involving codefendant Wesley.² And documents submitted in connection with codefendant Wesley's pending appeal, Docket No. 52127, indicate that the transcripts of his trial have been produced and filed in the district Under the circumstances, we relieve the court reporters of any court. further obligation to produce transcripts or file a certificate of delivery based on appellant's transcript request form. To the extent that counsel for appellant has not received the requested transcripts of codefendant Wesley's trial, he may obtain copies of those transcripts from the district court and, to the degree that they have any relevance to this court's review of this appeal, include them in an appendix as provided in NRAP 10 and 30.

Cause appearing, the motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix is granted in part. See NRAP 31(a)(1). Appellant shall have until February 25, 2008, to file and serve the opening

brief and appendix. No further extensions shall be permitted absent extreme and unforeseeable circumstances. Counsel's caseload will not be deemed such a circumstance. <u>Cf. Varnum v. Grady</u>, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974).

It is so ORDERED.
