**APPELLANT'S MOTION TO
ENLARGE TIME TO FILE
OPENING BRIEF AND APPENDIX**

Appellant, DELARIAN K. WILSON, by and through his counsel, JAMES A. ORONoz, ESQ., hereby submits his Motion to Enlarge Time to File Opening Brief and Appendix.

FACTUAL AND PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

Pursuant to District Court Case No. C232494, the Appellant, Delarian K. Wilson, was charged by way of Amended Criminal Complaint, with the following crimes: Count 1, Conspiracy to Commit Burglary; Count 2, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery; Counts 3 and 11, Burglary while in Possession of a Deadly Weapon; Counts 4, 5, 6, 7 and 9, Robbery with use of a Deadly Weapon; Count 8, Assault with use of a Deadly Weapon; Count 10, First Degree Kidnapping with use of a Deadly Weapon; Count 12, 13, 14, 15, and 17, Sexual Assault with a Deadly Weapon; Count 16, Coercion with use of a Deadly Weapon; and Count 18, Open or Gross Lewdness with use of a Deadly Weapon. On March 28, 2008, Wilson plead guilty to one count of Robbery with use of a Deadly Weapon and one count of Sexual Assault. Wilson was sentenced on July 3, 2008 as follows: Count 1: 72 Months to 180 Months with an equal and consecutive term of 72 Months to 180 Months; Count 2: 72 Months to 180 Months with an equal and consecutive term of 72 Months to 180 Months, consecutive to Count 1; Count 3: Life with Possibility of Parole, consecutive to Count 1. The Notice of Appeal was filed August 5, 2008.

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1 On September 10, 2008, Appellant filed a transcript request form requesting the
2 production of transcripts of numerous district court proceedings. On November 17, 2008, this
3 Court ordered court reporters Jackie Jenelle and Lee Bahr to produce the requested transcripts
4 within 30 days, with Appellant Wilson to have 70 days from the day of the order to file and
5 serve the Opening Brief and Appendix. To date, Appellant has not received transcripts for the
6 following requested dates: 4/10/08; 4/11/08; 4/14/08; 4/15/08; 4/16/08; 4/17/08; 4/18/2008; and
7 4/21/08.

8 ARGUMENT

9 GOOD CAUSE EXISTS TO ENLARGE THE TIME TO FILE APPELLANT'S OPENING BRIEF AND 10 APPENDIX.

11 NRAP 26 (b) provides, in relevant part, as follows: The court for good cause shown
12 may upon motion enlarge the time prescribed by these rules or by its order for doing any act, or
13 may permit an act to be done after the expiration of such time.

14 Because the Appellant has not yet received several transcripts he believes may be
15 relevant to his appeal, good cause exists to enlarge time for the filing of Appellant's Opening
16 Brief.

17 CONCLUSION

18 Based on the foregoing, Appellants Motion to Enlarge Time to File Opening Brief and
19 Appendix should be granted. Appellant requests an enlargement of time of 60 days.


