MEMORANDUM

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief. No previous extensions have been granted. As good cause for the extension, the State cites the large size of the record and number of pages in the Opening Brief.

This is an appeal from a district court's Judgment Of Conviction entered on May 6, 2009. There was an Amended Judgment of Conviction entered on May 14, 2009 due to a clerical error. Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal on May 22, 2009 and filed his Opening Brief on April 20, 2010. Respondent's Answering Brief is due on or before May 20, 2010.
