1 **MEMORANDUM**

2 I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case.  
3 The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering  
4 Brief. No previous extensions have been granted. As good cause for the extension, the State  
5 cites the large size of the record and number of pages in the Opening Brief.

6 This is an appeal from a district court's Judgment Of Conviction entered on May 6,  
7 2009. There was an Amended Judgment of Conviction entered on May 14, 2009 due to a  
8 clerical error. Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal on May 22, 2009 and filed his Opening  
9 Brief on April 20, 2010. Respondent's Answering Brief is due on or before May 20, 2010.

10 Pursuant to NRAP 26(b), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time  
11 prescribed by the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for doing any act, or may permit an  
12 act to be done after the expiration of such time.

13 This multiple count case, involving two Burglary convictions, involves a large record  
14 consisting of a four (4) volume appendix—consisting of 790 pages. The twenty-nine (29)  
15 page Opening Brief raises approximately five (5) main issues and over eight (8) sub-issues.

16 The State respectfully moves for an enlargement of time of thirty (30) days, making  
17 said brief due on June 21, 2010. This will give the State sufficient time to thoroughly review  
18 and respond fully to the material in Appellant's Opening Brief.
