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## **MEMORANDUM**

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time prescribed by the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for doing any act, or may permit an act to be done after the expiration of such time.

The Appellant's Opening Brief was filed on December 21, 2009. The Opening Brief is thirty-eight (38) pages using twelve-point font, raising numerous issues and sub-issues covering complex questions of trial court procedure, multiple instances of alleged judicial error and prosecutorial misconduct, that require a thorough review of the record contained in Defendant's three (3) volume, seven hundred fourteen (714) page appendix. This matter requires a thorough review by Respondent because it is being used as an aggravator in Appellant's upcoming capitol case. Additionally, the law clerk assigned to preparing the State's answer has numerous other briefs and post-conviction matters, including a death penalty case and several cases requiring evidentiary hearings for which he must adequately prepare and conduct, assigned to his making a proper response very difficult to achieve given the current schedule.

Based on the foregoing, the State requires an additional thirty (30) days to fully respond to this direct appeal from Defendant's conviction of First Degree Murder, Burglary, and Sexual Assault which resulted in a life sentence without the possibility of parole. The additional time will allow the State sufficient time to draft a brief which adequately addresses Appellant's issues and provide this Court with sufficient citation to legal authority to address the issues presented in Appellant's brief. This is the State's first Motion for an Extension of Time in this matter.
