
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO

1 POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

2 NRAP 31 states in pertinent part as follows:

3 "RULE 31. FILING AND SERVICE OF BRIEFS

4 (a) Time for Serving and Filing Briefs. Unless otherwise specified in these or any
5 other court rules, briefs shall be filed in accordance with the schedule set forth in this
6 Rule.


7 (1) All Appeals Except Child Custody, Visitation, or Capital Cases. The
8 appellant shall serve and file the opening brief within one hundred and twenty
9 (120) days after the date on which the appeal is docketed in the Supreme
10 Court...By written stipulation timely filed with the Supreme Court, the parties
11 may extend the time for filing any brief for a total of thirty (30) additional days
12 unless the court otherwise orders (see Rule 26(d)). Applications for extensions
13 of time beyond that to which the parties are permitted to stipulate are not
14 favored, and will be considered only on motion for good cause clearly shown,
15 or ex parte in cases of extreme and unforeseeable emergency....."

16 CONCLUSION

17 An extension of time of 90 days is requested to file Appellant's Opening Brief, up to
18 and including August 25, 2009.
