2	JONELL THOMAS, hereby declares as follows:
3	I am an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada, and the Deputy
4	Special Public Defender assigned to handle Mr. Flowers's appeal.
5	I currently have 15 appellate cases and in the last several weeks I have had oral
6	argument in Polk v. State before the Southern Panel of the Nevada Supreme Court; filed
7	opening briefs in Pearce v. State and Dieudonne v. State; filed a Writ of Certiorari to the
8	United States Supreme Court in Chappell v. State; and filed with this Court a Petition for
9	Rehearing in Walker v. State.
10	Within the next 30 days I will be filing an Opening Brief in the capital case of
11	Richardson v. State, which has already had a first request for extension of time granted. Also,
12	in <u>Harrison v. Sheriff</u> , the State filed a Petition for Rehearing of the Ninth Circuit Order
