15 of law, seize, confine, inveigle, entice, decoy, abduct, conceal, kidnap, or carry away TERESA
16 TYLER, a human being, with the intent to hold or detain the said TERESA TYLER, against her
17 will, and without her consent, for the purpose of committing robbery and/or sexual assault, said


