MEMORANDUM

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a fourteen (14) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief. As good cause for the extension, the State cites the complexity of the issues presented and the size of the record. Furthermore, the Deputy District Attorney who conducted the trial has reviewed the State's brief, and she believes information is missing and a more thorough review of the record is needed.

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time prescribed by the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for doing any act, or may permit an act to be done after the expiration of such time.
