ORDER

This matter, having come on for hearing before the above-entitled Court on the 26th day of August, 2009, for Respondent's Motion to Dismiss, and for Petitioner's Countermotion to Establish Custody, Support, and Award of Fees and Costs to Plaintiff; Petitioner, SEBASTIAN MARTINEZ, being present and represented by CHRISTOPHER A. AARON, ESQ., in an unbundled capacity; Respondent, ANTHONY FREDIANELLI, being present and represented by EDWARD L. KAINEN, ESQ., of the law firm of ECKER &



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KAINEN, CHARTERED; and Respondent, KRISTI RAE FREDIANELLI, being present and represented by MICHAEL P. CARMAN, ESQ., of the law firm of KUNIN & CARMAN; the Court, having reviewed the pleadings on file, having heard the arguments of counsel, and being fully advised in the premises, and good cause appearing therefor, makes the following findings and orders:

THE COURT HEREBY FINDS that the case of Scrimer v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Ct., 116 Nev. 507, 516, 998 P.2d 1190, 1196 (2000), is the controlling case law with respect to application and interpretation of NRCP 4(i).

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, upon the Court's review of the prior hearings in this matter, it is clear that the matter of service of process has been repeatedly addressed.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that at the hearing on October 15, 2007, Petitioner, Kristi Fredianelli (hereinafter "Kristi"), through her attorney, requested that this case be dismissed because Respondent, Anthony Fredianelli, (hereinafter "Tony"), was an indispensable party, but had not been named as a party to the litigation.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on October 15, 2007, the Court noted that for purposes of judicial economy, the case would not be dismissed. However, the Court noted that because of the child's age, time was of the essence and that Tony should be named as a party to the litigation and served as soon as possible. No specific orders for visitation were made at that time.

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on October 15, 2007, Kristi represented that Kristi and Tony's son, Joe, was enrolled in school in San Diego, California, and that Kristi intended to return to their home in San Diego, California.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that a hearing was conducted on July 15, 2008, at which time the Court addressed the Motion to Withdraw of Denise Pifer, Esq. Petitioner, Sebastian Martinez, (hereinafter "Sebastian"), did not appear at that hearing.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on July 15, 2008, questions were raised by the Court about service of the Amended Petition, as well as continuing questions about subject matter jurisdiction. The Amended Petition had not been properly served on Tony at that time. The Court then issued an Order to Show Cause for Sebastian to show cause, if any he had, why the case should not be dismissed.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that at the return hearing on August 19, 2008, Sebastian appeared and indicated a desire to proceed with the litigation. The Court found that service had not been effected on Tony and again directed Sebastian to serve Tony so as to bring him into the litigation.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that this matter returned for hearing on October 13, 2008. At that time, Sebastian did not appear at the hearing. The Court noted Sebastian's obligation to serve Tony with process, and expressed frustration that service had not been effectuated and that the case was lingering. Court considered scheduling a status check, but ultimately decided to vacate the hearing. The Court continued to await service of process on Tony by Sebastian.

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COURT FURTHER FINDS that, despite settlement negotiations for possible dismissal between Kristi and Sebastian, this matter lay dormant until March 2009, at which time, Sebastian filed a Motion to establish custody and visitation, which was heard by this Court on April 28, 2009.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that on April 28, 2009, this Court implemented a visitation schedule that was a departure from the prior orders by Judge Sanchez. It was not the Court's intent to reinvent or reconstruct the prior orders entered by the Court in this matter. However, it was clear that Sebastian had some contact with the minor child.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that it was the Court's intention to move this matter forward, but did note that service had not been effectuated on Tony at that time. The Court believed Tony had constructive knowledge of the litigation, was aware of the proceedings, and that he had not interjected himself into the proceedings. The Court questioned at that time whether Tony had any interest in participating in the litigation.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, because of the department reassignment in this matter, following the hearing on April 28, 2009, the Court felt that it was important to review the video transcripts from the prior proceedings in this matter.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Sebastian did not file a request for enlargement of the time to serve Tony pursuant to NRCP 6(b)(2).

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the Orders by Judge Sanchez on October 13, 2008, regarding service of process could be argued to be extensions of time for service of process pursuant to NRCP 4(i). On the other hand, the Court made it clear on several occasions, however, that Tony was required to be served.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, even if the Court considered the hearing on October 13, 2008, as an extension by the Court of the time for service of process, more than 120 days elapsed between that hearing and the actual service of process upon Tony in May 2009.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that NRCP 4(i) is intended to facilitate the legal process and to ensure that cases do not languish indefinitely. This must be balanced with the Court's policy to decided a case on its merits.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the Court is a Court of law, as well as a Court of equity.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that it is very concerned about the fact that Tony was not served for a period of over eighteen (18) months after the filing of the Amended Petition (twenty-five months from the initial Petition), despite having been directed by the Court several occasions to do so.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that an analysis of Scrimer v. <u>Eighth Judicial Dist. Ct.</u>, results in the following:

(1) The difficulties in locating Tony: The Court finds that no difficulties were shown. Further, no request for enlargement of time was ever made.

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(2) Tony's efforts at evading service of concealment of improper service until after the 120-day period lapsed:

The Court finds that there has been no showing of attempts by Tony to evade service or conceal himself.

- (3) <u>Sebastian's diligence in attempting to serve Tony</u>: The Court finds that there was only one attempt at service of process, which attempt was previously found to have been ineffective by this Court. There does not appear to be any diligence by Sebastian herein.
- (4) <u>Difficulties encountered by counsel</u>: The Court finds there was not any showing of difficulties by counsel.
- (5) The running of the applicable statute of limitations:
 This factor is inapplicable in this matter.
- (6) The parties' good faith attempt to settle the litigation during the 120-day period: The Court finds that although there appears to have been settlement negotiations between Kristi and Sebastian for a dismissal of the action, there were no settlement negotiations between Sebastian and Tony.
- The lapse of time between the end of the 120-day period and the actual service of process on Tony: The Court finds that whether it considers the lapse of time between the filing of the Amended Petition and the date of service, or the lapse of time between the hearing on October 18, 2008, and the date of service, the lapse of time was significant.

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(8) The prejudice to Tony caused by Sebastian's delay in serving process: The Court finds that the delay caused by Sebastian in effectuating service has absolutely delayed the prosecution of this matter. The Court also understands Tony's arguments of prejudice based upon the UCCJEA and the potential application of California law.

(9) Tony's knowledge of the existence of the lawsuit: The Court finds that, although Tony was generally aware of the pending litigation between Kristi and Sebastian, he was never made specifically aware that an Amended Petition had been filed in which he had been named as a party; and

district court. The Court finds that, at best, the Court's orders in October 2008, may be argued to be an extension within which to effectuate service of process.

Notwithstanding the same, and despite the expressed frustrations of Judge Sanchez with regard to Sebastian's failure to serve Tony, there was a long delay before service of process was effectuated, during which the case was dormant and languished in the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing findings,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to NRCP 4(i), this matter shall be, and hereby is, dismissed in its entirety due to Petitioner's failure to effectuate service of process on the Respondent, Anthony Fredianelli.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that based on this dismissal, the Court cannot and will not make orders with regard to the remainder of the relief requested by Petitioner and/or either Respondent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, based on the foregoing, all other orders entered in this matter are invalid and unenforceable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner, Sebastian Martinez, shall be, and hereby is, ordered to pay the sum of \$500 as and for attorney's fees to counsel for Respondents, Kristi Fredianelli and Anthony Fredianelli, as a result of the delay in proceeding with the hearing on today's date.

CARMAN, ESQ., of the law firm of KUNIN & CARMAN; the Court, having reviewed the pleadings on file, having heard the arguments of counsel, and being fully advised in the premises, and good cause appearing therefor, makes the following findings and orders:

THE COURT HEREBY FINDS that the case of Scrimer v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Ct., 116 Nev. 507, 516, 998 P.2d 1190, 1196 (2000), is the controlling case law with respect to application and interpretation of NRCP 4(i).

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, upon the Court's review of the prior hearings in this matter, it is clear that the matter of service of process has been repeatedly addressed.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that at the hearing on October 15, 2007, Petitioner, Kristi Fredianelli (hereinafter "Kristi"), through her attorney, requested that this case be dismissed because Respondent, Anthony Fredianelli, (hereinafter "Tony"), was an indispensable party, but had not been named as a party to the litigation.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on October 15, 2007, the Court noted that for purposes of judicial economy, the case would not be dismissed. However, the Court noted that because of the child's age, time was of the essence and that Tony should be named as a party to the litigation and served as soon as casent possible. No specific orders for visitation were made at that unburdled time.

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on October 15, 2007, Kristi represented that Kristi and Tony's son, Joe, was enrolled in school in San Diego, California, and that Kristi intended to return to their home in San Diego, California.

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, at the hearing on July 15, 2008, questions were raised by the Court about service of the Amended Petition, as well as continuing questions about subject matter jurisdiction. The Amended Petition had not been properly served on Tony at that time. The Court then issued an Order to Show Cause for Sebastian to show cause, if any he had, why the case should not be dismissed.

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that this matter returned for hearing on October 13, 2008. At that time, Sebastian did not appear at the hearing. The Court noted Sebastian's obligation to serve Tony with process, and expressed frustration that service had not been effectuated and that the case was lingering. Court considered scheduling a status check, but ultimately decided to vacate the hearing. The Court continued to await service of process on Tony by Sebastian.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, despite settlement negotiations for possible dismissal between Kristi and Sebastian, this matter lay dormant until March 2009, at which time, Sebastian filed a Motion to establish custody and visitation, which was heard by this Court on April 28, 2009.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that on April 28, 2009, this Court implemented a visitation schedule that was a departure from the prior orders by Judge Sanchez. It was not the Court's intent to reinvent or reconstruct the prior orders entered by the Court in this matter. However, it was clear that Sebastian had some contact with the minor child.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that it was the Court's intention to move this matter forward, but did note that service had not been effectuated on Tony at that time. The Court believed Tony had constructive knowledge of the litigation, was aware of the proceedings, and that he had not interjected himself into the proceedings. The Court questioned at that time whether Tony had any interest in participating in the litigation.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, because of the department reassignment in this matter, following the hearing on April 28, 2009, the Court felt that it was important to review the video transcripts from the prior proceedings in this matter.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Sebastian did not file a request for enlargement of the time to serve Tony pursuant to NRCP 6 (b). (2): Physical Parts **:.:**: A 144 11 117 1.877 1.833 Q.L

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THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the Orders by Judge Sanchez on October 13, 2008, regarding service of process could be argued to be extensions of time for service of process pursuant to NRCP 4(i). On the other hand, the Court made it clear on several occasions, however, that Tony was required to be served.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, even if the Court considered the hearing on October 13, 2008, as an extension by the Court of the time for service of process, more than 120 days elapsed between that hearing and the actual service of process upon Tony in May 2009.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that NRCP 4(i) is intended to facilitate the legal process and to ensure that cases do not languish indefinitely. This must be balanced with the Court's policy to decided a case on its merits.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the Court is a Court of law, as well as a Court of equity.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that it is very concerned about the fact that Tony was not served for a period of over eighteen (18) months after the filing of the Amended Petition (twenty-five months from the initial Petition), despite having been directed by the Court several occasions to do so.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that an analysis of Scrimer v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Ct., results in the following:

(1)The difficulties in locating Tony: The Court finds that no difficulties were shown. Further, no request for enlargement of time was ever made.

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(2) Tony's efforts at evading service of concealment of improper service until after the 120-day period lapsed: The Court finds that there has been no showing of attempts by Tony to evade service or conceal himself.

- (3) Sebastian's diligence in attempting to serve Tony: Court finds that there was only one attempt at service of process, which attempt was previously found to have been ineffective by this Court. There does not appear to be any diligence by Sebastian herein.
- (4)Difficulties encountered by counsel: The Court finds there was not any showing of difficulties by counsel.
- (5) The running of the applicable statute of limitations: This factor is inapplicable in this matter.
- (6)The parties' good faith attempt to settle the litigation during the 120-day period: The Court finds that although there appears to have been settlement negotiations between Kristi and Sebastian for a dismissal of the action, there were no settlement negotiations between Sebastian and Tony.
- (7) The lapse of time between the end of the 120-day period and the actual service of process on Tony: The Court finds that whether it considers the lapse of time between the filing of the Amended Petition and the date of service, or the lapse of time between the hearing on October 18, 2008, and the date of service, the lapse of time was significant.

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(8) The prejudice to Tony caused by Sebastian's delay in serving process: The Court finds that the delay caused by Sebastian in effectuating service has absolutely delayed the prosecution of this matter. The Court also understands Tony's arguments of prejudice based upon the UCCJEA and the potential application of California law.

- (9) Tony's knowledge of the existence of the lawsuit: The Court finds that, although Tony was generally aware of the pending litigation between Kristi and Sebastian, he was never made specifically aware that an Amended Petition had been filed in which he had been named as a party; and
- (10) Any extensions of time for service granted by the district court. The Court finds that, at best, the Court's orders in October 2008, may be argued to be an extension within which to effectuate service of process. Notwithstanding the same, and despite the expressed frustrations of Judge Sanchez with regard to Sebastian's failure to serve Tony, there was a long delay before service of process was effectuated, during which the case was dormant and languished in the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing findings,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to NRCP 4(i), this matter shall be, and hereby is, dismissed in its entirety due to Petitioner's failure to effectuate servicepof process on the Respondent, Anthony Fredianelli.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that based on this dismissal, the Court cannot and will not make orders with regard to the remainder of the relief requested by Petitioner and/or either Respondent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, based on the foregoing, all other orders entered in this matter are invalid and unenforceable.

FURTHER ORDERED IS that Petitioner, Sebastian Martinez, shall be, and hereby is, ordered to pay the sum of \$500 as and for attorney's fees to counsel for Respondents, Kristi Fredianelli and Anthony Fredianelli, as a result of the delay in proceeding with the hearing on today's date.

After further arguments by counsel, COURT ORDERED, the following:

Ms. Pifer is directed to file an Amended Petition naming Defendant's husband and child as Parties and to send an Order appointing a Guardian Ad Litem (GAL) for the child.

Court noted, for judicial economy and to conserve the Parties' financial resources, it would not be prudent to dismiss the Petition as the Parties would incur additional filing fees and the case would be linked to this Department and it would still have to hear the issues on the merits.
