When County sought review of the Tax Commission's Decision subsequently voided by Chanos v. Nevada Tax Commission, ____ Nev. ____, 181 P.3d 675 (Nev. 2008), it was required to seek judicial review and not a hearing de novo, Taxpayers should be confined to the same remedy.
