

<u>O R D E R</u>

Clark County has moved for leave to file a brief of amicus curiae in this matter. NRAP 29 governs amicus curiae briefs in this court and provides, as is relevant here, that "[t]he United States, the State of Nevada, an officer or agency of either, a political subdivision thereof, or a state, territory or commonwealth may file an amicus curiae brief without the consent of the parties or leave of court." Under this authority, this court does not require a motion for leave to be filed by Clark County. Accordingly, no action is required with respect to its motion, and the clerk shall file the amicus curiae brief received on February 25, 2010.
