

*ORDER DENYING MOTION*

The Special Public Defender (SPD) has filed a motion to withdraw as counsel for appellant. In support of the motion, the SPD states that, after this court dismissed these appeals, it filed notices of withdrawal as attorney of record in the district court and the district court orally granted appellant's pro se motion to dismiss counsel. The SPD asserts that this court's case management system was not updated after the appeals were reinstated to remove it as counsel.

The notices of withdrawal filed in the district court and the oral order made by the court were of no effect in this appeal. *See* NRAP 46(d)(1). And the SPD otherwise fails to demonstrate good cause to withdraw as counsel. Accordingly, the motion is denied without prejudice. The SPD shall have 20 days from the date of this order to comply with this court's August 16, 2018, order.

It is so ORDERED.
