
NOTICE OF RULE CHANGE

Notice is hereby given that on April 8, 2002, the Supreme Court of Nevada entered an order in ADKT Nos. 171, 176, and 240 amending the Supreme Court Rules. The order amends Rule 49 and Addenda 1 and 2 relating to the administrative policies, procedures, guidelines, and terms of the members of the Board of Bar Examiners, the Moral Character and Fitness Committee, and the Functional Equivalency Committee. The amendment is effective immediately.

Rule changes are published by the Supreme Court Clerk in the same manner as an opinion of the court. In accordance with the Nevada Rules on the Administrative Docket, Section 6, the Clerk will disseminate printed copies of the order without charge to all subscribers to the advance opinions of the Nevada
