

ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADOPTION OF STANDARDIZED FORMS FOR MANDATORY USE IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTION ORDER CASES

WHEREAS on April 17, 1998, this court approved the petition filed herein and appointed a committee to study the need for adoption of standardized forms for protection orders in cases of domestic violence in all courts of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS on December 28, 1998, the study committee filed with this court its findings and recommendations in the form of a motion for adoption and voluntary use of standardized forms; and

WHEREAS on June 1, 1999, this court approved and adopted the standardized forms for protection orders in cases of domestic violence in all courts of the State of Nevada for immediate use on a voluntary basis by the District Courts and Justice Courts of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS on January 31, 2000, the study committee filed with this court its findings and recommendations in the form of a motion for adoption of standardized forms for mandatory use in domestic violence protection order cases; and

WHEREAS the study committee has developed the following seven standardized forms previously adopted by this court and approved for immediate use on a voluntary basis by the District Courts and Justice Courts of the State of Nevada:

- (1) Application for Order for Protection Against Domestic Violence;
- (2) Temporary Order for Protection Against Domestic Violence;
- (3) Domestic Violence Order for Protection Information Sheet
- (4) Order for Protection Return of Service
- (5) Order for Hearing to Extend, Modify, or Dissolve the Order for Protection;
- (6) Notice for Hearing to Extend, Modify, or Dissolve the Order for Protection:
- (7) Extended Order for Protection Against Domestic Violence; and

WHEREAS the study committee has developed five additional standardized forms and recommends approval and adoption for immediate use on a

voluntary basis by the District Courts and Justice Courts of the State of Nevada, as follows:

- (1) Motion and Affidavit to Modify or Dissolve the Order for Protection;
- (2) Order;
- (3) Notices to the Adverse Party for Temporary Order;
- (4) Notices to the Adverse Party for Extended Order;
- (5) Certification of Order for Protection; and

WHEREAS, the study committee has determined that a training program should be developed and offered to law enforcement personnel, prosecutors, judges, court staff and other affected professionals on use of the forms, and has reported that the Administrative Office of the Courts has received a training grant from the Violence Against Women Act program administered by the Office of the Attorney General for this purpose;

Accordingly, cause appearing, we hereby grant the motion for adoption of standardized forms; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- (1) Effective immediately, all orders for protection against domestic violence issued in accordance with the provisions set forth in NRS 33 shall utilize the seven standardized forms developed by the study committee, copies of which are attached to this order as Exhibits 1 through 7. The seven forms were previously adopted and approved by this court for voluntary use and are now adopted for mandatory use in all cases involving orders for protection against domestic violence in all courts of the State of Nevada;
- (2) The five additional standardized forms developed by the study committee, copies of which are attached to this order as Exhibits 8 through 12, are adopted and approved for immediate use on a voluntary basis, effective immediately, by the District Courts and Justice Courts of the State of Nevada;
- (3) The Administrative Office of the Courts, in conjunction with other agencies involved, is encouraged to continue to work on the training program being developed through a grant from the Violence Against Women Act administered by the Office of the Attorney General;
- (4) The study committee shall meet on or before November 1, 2000, to review and revise the five additional forms, as necessary, in light of their utilization;

(5) The study committee shall file with this court, on or before January 1, 2001, supplemental findings and recommendations and proposed changes, if any, to the additional five standardized forms; and

(6) This court's permanent adoption of the additional five standardized forms for mandatory use by all District Courts and Justice Courts in the State of Nevada which have jurisdiction to issue orders for protection against domestic violence shall be deferred pending receipt of the study committee's supplemental findings and recommendations.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that any VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIMINAL VIOLATION and will result in a misdemeanor offense, unless a more severe penalty is prescribed by law. If the violation is accompanied by a violent physical act, sentence will include incarceration of not less than five days nor more than six months in the county/city jail; \$1,000.00 fine or a minimum of 200 hours community service; reimbursement of all costs, fees and medical expenses incurred; and participation in professional counseling.

YOU ARE FURTHER NDTIFIED that you CAN BE ARRESTED even if the person who obtained the order invites or allows you to contact them. You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from violating the terms of this order. Only the court can change the order upon written application.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that child stealing is a felony offense, punishable by possible incarceration.

This order meets all Full Faith and Credit provisions of the Violence Against Women Act and is enforceable in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, U.S. Territories and Indian Nations. All other courts and law enforcement with jurisdiction within the United States and all Indian Nations shall give full faith and credit to this Order pursuant to 18 U.S.C. Sec. 2265.

Violation of the order may subject you, the offender, to federal charges and punishment pursuant to 18 U.S.C. Sec. 2261(a)(1) and (2) and 2262(a)(1) and (2).

An application and affidavit having been filed in this Court by the above-named Applicant requesting that a Temporary Order for Protection against Domestic Violence be issued by this Court against YOU, the above-named Adverse Party, or the Court having received specific facts by telephone/facsimile pursuant to NRS 33.020(5), and the Court having jurisdiction over the parties and this matter pursuant to NRS 33.010, et seq., and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from specific facts shown by a verified application that an act of domestic violence has occurred and/or you represent a credible threat to the physical safety of the above-named Applicant or minor child(ren) and good cause appearing for issuing such Order without hearing, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

ļ	ORDER TO LAW ENFORCEMENT
10	(A) Any law enforcement officer who has probable cause to believe a violation of any provision of this
11	Order has occurred is ordered to arrest the Adverse Party. Such party is to be charged with a misdemeanor
12	violation of this Order in addition to any other criminal charges which may be justified.
13	(B) If such law enforcement officer cannot verify that the Adverse Party was served with a copy of
14	the Application and Order, the officer shall inform the Adverse Party of the specific terms of the Order, inform
- 1	the Adverse Party that he/she now has notice of the provisions of the Order and that a violation of the Order will result in his/her arrest, and inform the Adverse Party of the location of the court that issued the original
15	order and the hours during which he/she can obtain a copy of the Order. The law enforcement officer shall
16	then provide written proof of notice to his agency and to the Court.
