IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the committee shall consider and prepare recommendations concerning a comprehensive system of court rules and statutes that will alleviate the burdensome costs and delays that currently plague the judicial system of this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the committee shall present

its findings and recommendations to this court on or before September 1, 1990.
