ORDER EXTENDING THE
NEVADA RULES OF ARBITRATION

WHEREAS, an experimental program of mandatory, non-binding arbitration has been established in the Second and Eighth Judicial Districts of the State of Nevada pursuant to NRS 38.250 through NRS 38.258, and the Nevada Rules of Arbitration; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Rules of Arbitration contained in Subpart A of Part V of the Nevada Supreme Court Rules are scheduled to expire by limitation on January 1, 1994; and


WHEREAS, it appears to the court that the experimental program of arbitration established pursuant to the above referenced statutes and rules should be extended pending further study and review by the legislature and the court;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Nevada Arbitration Rules shall remain in effect pending such further study and review, and pending further order of the court;


IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall become effective on January 1, 1994. The clerk of this court

shall mail a copy of this order to each member of the State Bar of Nevada according to the clerk's official list of membership.


