ORDER APPOINTING ATTORNEY ARBITRATOR

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sharon E. Claassen, an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and qualified to serve as an arbitrator pursuant to Nevada Arbitration Rule 7, is appointed as an attorney arbitrator for the Court Annexed Arbitration Program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Sharon E. Claassen shall attend the next arbitration orientation and training program offered by the State Bar of Nevada and shall provide this court with proof of completion of the program. See NAR 7(C). In the interim she may assume all of the duties and responsibilities of an attorney arbitrator.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Sharon E. Claassen may be sworn or affirmed as provided in NAR 7 and shall submit her oath to the arbitration commissioner for the judicial district where she will serve as an arbitrator. The arbitration commissioner shall maintain a list of active members of the panel of arbitrators as required by NAR 7.
