

NOTICE OF RULE CHANGE

Notice is hereby given that on July 26, 2002, the Supreme Court of Nevada entered an order in ADKT No. 126 amending the Nevada Arbitration Rules. The order amends Rule 7(B) relating to the qualifications of non-attorney arbitrators and repeals Rule 7(G) regarding the prohibition against an arbitrator advertising his or her status as a member of the court-annexed arbitration panel. The amendment shall become effective on September 24, 2002.

Rule changes are published by the Supreme Court Clerk in the same manner as an opinion of the court. In accordance with the Nevada Rules on the Administrative Docket, Section 6, the Clerk will disseminate printed copies of the order without charge to all subscribers to the advance opinions of the Nevada Reports.
